

Gospel: Luke 9:11b-17

"They all ate and were satisfied."

Gospel Teaching:

The Gospel is the story of the "loaves and fishes", how over five thousand were satisfied with only five loaves and two fish. Jesus had been teaching the crowd all day and healing those in need, but it was getting late. The Apostles wanted Jesus to stop and send the people away so they could get some food. Jesus tells the Apostles to give them food. When they say they only have a little, Jesus asks them to show their trust in him and have the

crowd sit down. He takes what little they had, blessed it and gave it to them to pass out. There was food left over after all had eaten. What can we learn from this? God will provide all we need if we trust in him and do what he asks of us.
