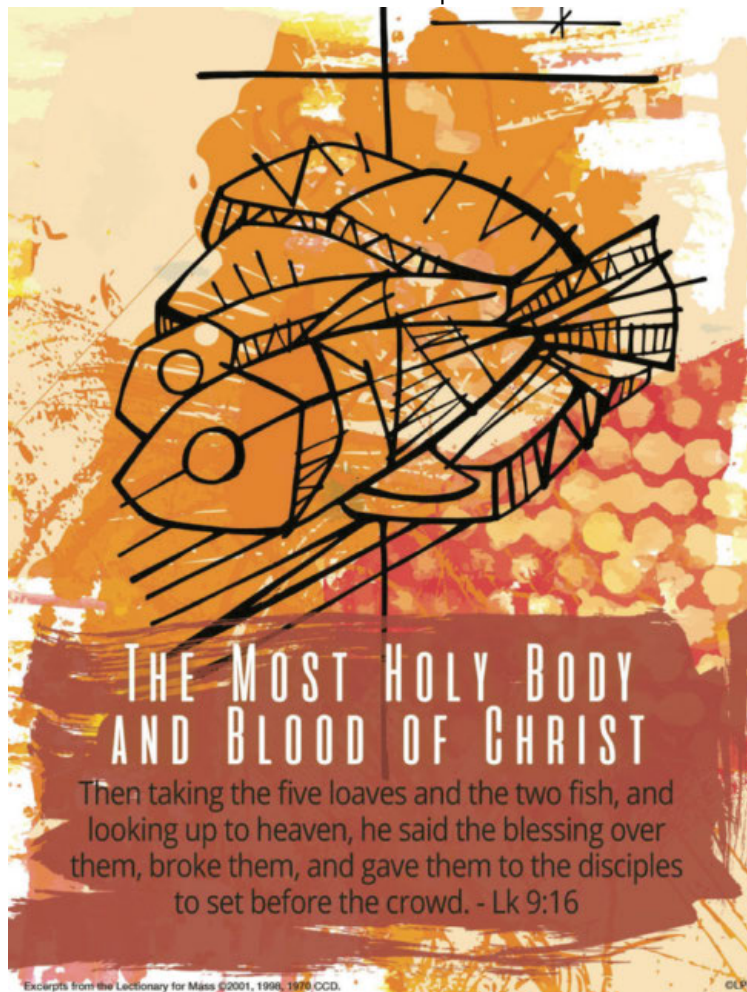

GOSPEL REFLECTION

Gospel: *Luke 9:11b-17*
 “They all ate and were satisfied.”

Gospel Teaching:

The Gospel is the story of the “loaves and fishes”, how over five thousand were satisfied with only five loaves and two fish. Jesus had been teaching the crowd all day and healing those in need, but it was getting late. The Apostles wanted Jesus to stop and send the people away so they could get some food. Jesus tells the Apostles to give them food. When they say they only have a little, Jesus asks them to show their trust in him and have the crowd sit down. He takes what little they had, blessed it and gave it to them to pass out. There was food left over after all had eaten. What can we learn from this? God will provide all we need if we trust in him and do what he asks of us.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION TEAM MEMBERS NEEDED

We are looking for volunteers to participate in our Family Faith Formation. We want to draw on the wisdom of members of the parish by forming a team of volunteers to facilitate our Sunday sessions. Volunteers would not need to commit to every week. Most Sundays the entire family will meet together. We would like to identify team member's gifts. A team member's gifts to present topic (5-7 minutes), witness, or, for those of you familiar with Alpha a facilitator might be utilized at a family table to lead discussion. We would also need team members who would be comfortable in a classroom setting once a month, with a group of children in an age-specific group.

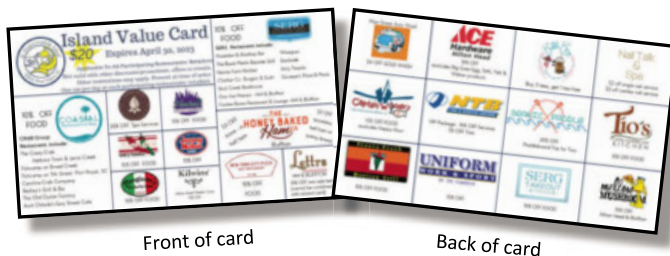
SAFE ENVIRONMENT SCREENING

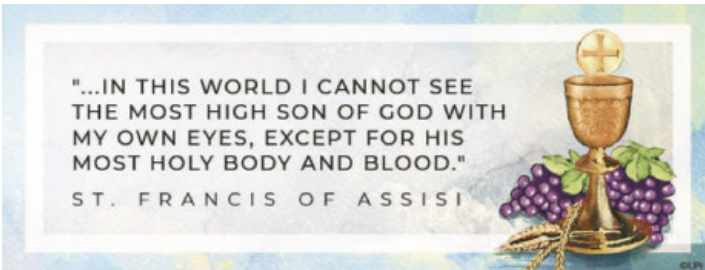

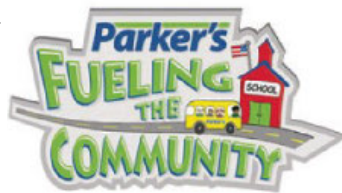

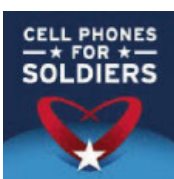

PARKING LOT REFURBISHMENT UPDATE

As part of the renovation we will:

- Bring the parking lot up to the latest ADA standards, including 10 accessible parking spaces at the front of the church. There will be a total of 24 accessible parking spaces.
- Add a new drainage system to remove water from the parking surface.
- 31 new pole lights throughout the parking lot.
- Add walkways throughout the parking lot with additional lighting.
- Repave the parking lot.
- Add a new irrigation system and new plantings throughout the parking lot.
- Replace the sidewalks throughout the Church property.

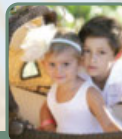

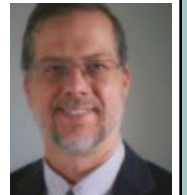

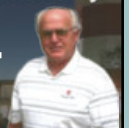
