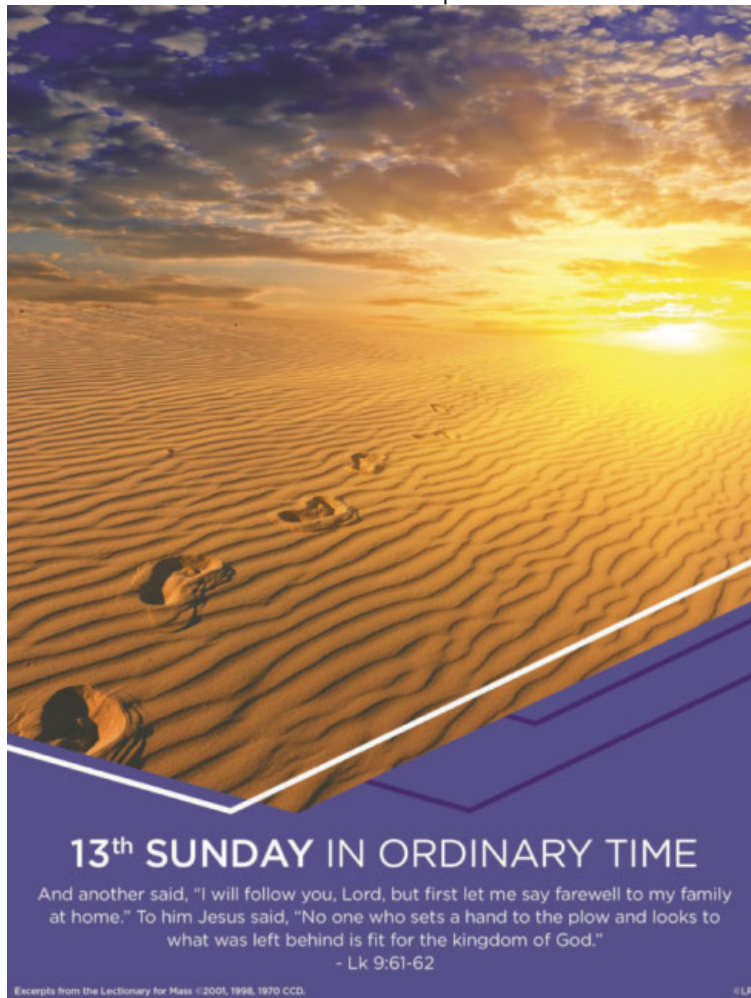

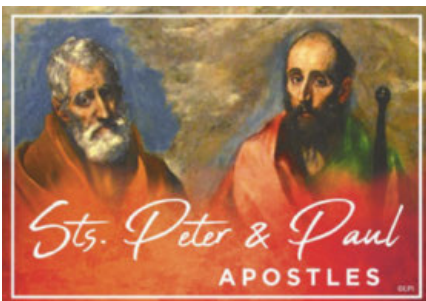

Peter, the head of the Apostles, and Paul, the great Apostle to the Gentiles, have been remembered together on this date since ancient times. Peter started life as Simon, a fisherman who worked alongside his brother Andrew. Jesus changed his name to Cephas (Greek: Petros), meaning “rock.” Thus, “on this rock, I will build my Church.”



Paul had been Saul, a Pharisee and proud persecutor of Christians. After an encounter with the risen Christ on the road to Damascus, he gave his life to preaching the Gospel throughout Asia Minor. Tradition holds that both men were martyred in Rome.

Gospel: Luke 9:51-62

"I will follow you wherever you go."

Gospel Teaching:

Jesus is going to Jerusalem. Luke's Gospel says he "resolutely determined" to go on the journey, even though he knew what awaited him there. His resolution to not be deterred from the journey is shown in what he tells others during the trip. They should not stop to take revenge on those who will not welcome you. There will be no rest. Other tasks, burying relatives or saying farewell to family, must be forgotten. The spiritual journey that God has asked us to go on must be first and foremost in our lives. We should all be resolved in our determination to do whatever is necessary to keep us on the straight and narrow path that will lead us to our heavenly reward.

Children are good for the environment! So says Pope Francis, who emphasized the irreplaceable role of the traditional family: "The mutual love between man and woman is a reflection of the absolute and unfailing love with which God loves the human being, destined to be fruitful and to find fulfilment in the common work of the social order and the care of creation." The pope contradicted radical environmentalists who see man as the enemy of the environment and who propose population control as the solution. Having children "should never be considered as a lack of responsibility towards creation," Francis said. "The concept of 'environmental footprint' cannot be applied to children, since they are an indispensable resource for the future" and families are "the best example of the optimization of resources involving large economies of scale."

PARKING LOT UPDATE

The sidewalks have been removed from around the Mary-side of the church and a new sidewalk has been poured by the exit of the church (near the new columbarium). There is currently no access to the existing columbarium until the new sidewalk has cured. We will notify the parish when access to the columbarium is permitted.

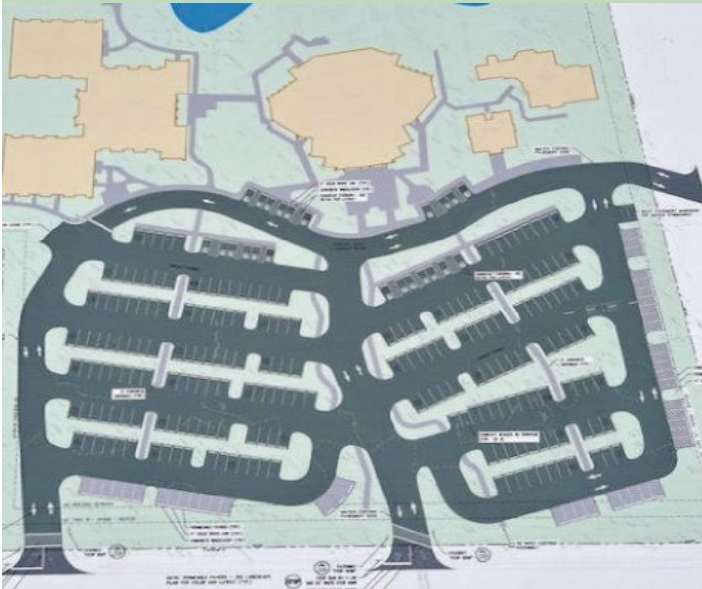
Parking for the Daily Masses should only be in the gym parking lot. Please **DO NOT PARK** in the circle in front of the gym, in the physician's parking lot across from the gym, or Hospital Center Commons. These are places of business during the week and we must not deter the business or their patients from getting to their appointments.

OVERALL PLAN

As part of the renovation we will:

- Bring the parking lot up to the latest ADA standards, including 10 accessible parking spaces at the front of the church. There will be a total of 24 accessible parking spaces.
- Add a new drainage system to remove water from the parking surface.
- 31 new pole lights throughout the parking lot.
- Add walkways throughout the parking lot with additional lighting.
- Repave the parking lot.
- Add a new irrigation system and new plantings throughout the parking lot.
- Replace the sidewalks throughout the Church property.
