

Saint Henry was born in 972 to Henry, Duke of Bavaria, Germany, and his wife Gisela of Burgundy. Saint Henry's early life was permeated with Christianity, among those who guided his education was Bishop Wolfgang of Ratisbon, who became a saint himself. In 995, Saint Henry succeeded his father as Duke of Bavaria, and in 1002, upon the death of his cousin, Otho III, he was elected emperor. In 1014, Saint Henry undertook the long journey from Germany to Rome to be crowned Holy Roman Emperor by Pope Benedict XIII.

In 1022 Saint Henry assisted Pope Benedict VIII in holding the Council of Pavia, which promoted clerical celibacy and sought to end simony (the buying

and selling of ecclesiastical goods and offices). During his reign, Saint Henry used his wealth and position for the Church. He confirmed Benedict's authority over Rome, was a patron of churches and monasteries, supported the Cluniac Reforms, restored episcopal sees, and founded the Diocese of Bamburg where he built a cathedral. Saint Henry was married to Cunigunde of Luxembourg, to whom he was incredibly devoted. Although disputed by some historians, some stories of the couple's marriage report they took vows of chastity because their union was childless.

Saint Henry died in July of 1024 and was canonized in 1146 by Pope Eugene III.

GOSPEL REFLECTION

Gospel: *Luke 10:25-37* "And who is my neighbor?"

Gospel Teaching:

The story of the "Good Samaritan" from today's Gospel is well known. What may not be well known is that the Jews in the time of Jesus hated the Samaritans. When the Jews from Galilee when south to Judea, they often when east of the Jordan, crossing the river twice, rather than go through Samaria. In the story, two people who would be expected to be helpful, a priest and a Levite, passed the injured person, but the hated Samaritan went out of his way to care for him. When Jesus asks the scholar which of the people in the story acted as a "neighbor to the robbers' victim?", the scholar answers "The

one who treated him with mercy". He cannot even use the term "Samaritan" to describe him. Jesus tells him, "Go and do likewise." Do we act as a neighbor to those we do not like?

Sidewalks are now in around the Family Center. However, all sidewalks have been removed and will be removed from around the Parish Office and the Plaza of the Church. If you need access to the columbarium (both horizontal and vertical), please use the sidewalks from the Mary side of the Church.

- Add a new irrigation system and new plantings throughout the parking lot.
- Replace the sidewalks throughout the Church property.

The Diocese of Charleston Stewardship Bulletin

July/August, 2022

School is out! We hear many children say, "I'm bored!" or "there's nothing to do!" Here are a few ideas to help children grow in their understanding of Stewardship as a Way of Life.

Plan and carry out a neighborhood clean-up and recycle day... Make one day each week your stewardship of your neighborhood day. Give each child a garbage bag and latex gloves. Make one garbage bag for recyclables and the other for garbage. Go for a walk, picking up the trash and putting it in the proper bag. When you get back to your house, put the material collected in the proper receptacle.

Write a Litany of Gratitude...Give your children a special notepad and pencil for recording a Litany of Gratitude. Ask them to write down things for which they are grateful all during the day. Some examples might be: a kind word from a friend, a beautiful flower, the softness of a puppy, some help with chores, a favorite song, a refreshing swim, cold lemonade, etc. At the end of the day make the litany part of your night prayer. Have as a response, "Thank you, God, and help us to care for all you have given us."

15º Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Así es, Dios nunca nos pide algo que no podamos hacer. Nuestras manos y corazón están a la medida de lo que se debe de hacer. Aunque, a veces se sienta que no se puede pasar por la experiencia que se vive, Dios da la fuerza y se avanza, muchas veces arriesgando la propia vida. En la primera lectura de este domingo, Dios alienta al pueblo en su travesía por el desierto de la siguiente manera: "Todo lo contrario, mi palabra ha llegado bien cerca de ti; ya la tienes en la boca y sabes de memoria, y solo hace falta ponerla en práctica" (Deuteronomio 30,14); asegurando su cercanía y poniendo en práctica su fe y confianza de lo aprendido de su misma experiencia del camino.

El Papa Francisco, en una de sus tantas catequesis dominicales, nos pide asegurarnos de preguntarnos lo siguiente: ¿Nuestra fe es fecunda? ¿Nuestra fe produce obras buenas? ¿O es más bien estéril, y, por tanto, está más muerta que viva? ¿Me hago prójimo o simplemente paso de largo? La última pregunta de este perfecto examen de conciencia de este domingo del buen samaritano es la siguiente: ¿Soy de aquellos que seleccionan a la gente según su propio gusto? Y, es más, el Papa Francisco recomienda que estas preguntas nos las hagamos frecuentemente, no una vez al día, sino varias veces en la jornada del día. El buen samaritano y el posadero son los ejemplos de este Evangelio. ¿Cuál deseas imitar tú?
