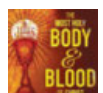

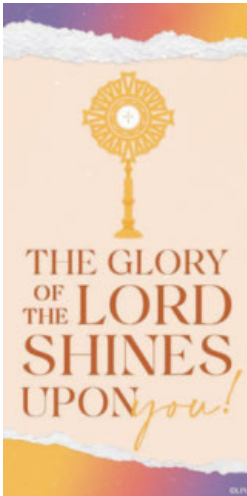

GOSPEL REFLECTION

Gospel: *Matthew 28: 16-20*

"I am with you always, until the end of the age."

Gospel Reflection:

Matthew's Gospel has the eleven returning to Galilee after the Resurrection where they see Jesus at the top of a mountain. In the same way that they received a commission from Jesus in Mark's Gospel of two weeks ago, and John's Gospel last week, Jesus tells them "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations." He provided the words that are used to this day for bring people into the church – "baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." They are to teach the people "to observe all that I have commanded you."
