You are reminded of the Church's laws for fast and abstinence during Lent, which begins on Ash Wednesday, Feb 17th. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fasting. Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 are permitted one full meal and two lesser meals per day (which together should not equal one full meal), with no eating between meals.

Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence. Catholics who are 14 years or older should abstain from meat entirely. Soups and gravies made from meat are permitted.

The Diocesan Ministry Formation Program (MFP) seeks quality candidates for its next class, which begins in August 2022. The MFP is the minimal standard for leaders in catechesis, adult faith formation, youth ministry, RCIA, to name some areas. It is a requirement for those who are called to the diaconate. The program, now in its 30th year, provides its candidates with opportunities for growth in the following areas: theological, human, spiritual developments, and pastoral ministry. The endorsement of one's pastor is a requirement for application. Parishes who have not recently sent applicants to the program or the information sessions will receive their own information packets next week via mail. Fifty years ago , when the Franciscan priests of our parish were living in a double wide trailer in the north parking lot,, the parishioners raised the money to build our existing rectory and offices. In the half century since, we have been well served by this building that your parents built with their own hands . Now it's time for this generation to respond to current pressing needs and update the priests' house and parish offices.

This Building Project has three inter-locking STEPS

- 1.) Safety for the four priests that live in the rectory c.. \$ 70,000
- 2.) New and more adequate office space c. \$ 150,000
- 3.) Repairs and renovation of the old office & rectory c. \$ 180,000
c \$ 400,000

The current offices make privacy and confidentiality in counseling and confessions very difficult. There is not enough space for the staff to do its best work; we are clumped and clustered together. Additionally, the wiring needs of modern electronics and business communications demand more sophisticated designs. The intrusion of office activities in the living space of the priests is jarring and uncomfortable; the lack of a living room makes the visiting of priests, friends, family and parishioners nearly impossible. If you should wish to express financially your gratitude for our hundred years of priestly service, we ask you to steer your kindness and thankfulness away from us directly, and into a pledge for SAN SEBASTIAN STEPS UP. 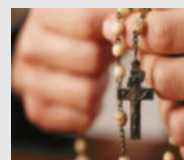

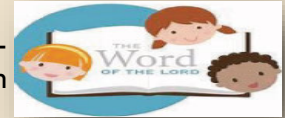

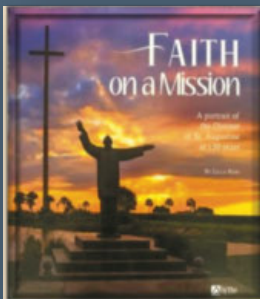
