

Breath of New Life

The second Sunday of Easter, the last day of the Octave of Easter, has had different names throughout Church History. Because of the first line in the Latin Entrance antiphon, referring to new believers as newborn infants, today was known as 'Quasimodo Sunday' for whom the title character in Victor Hugo's, *The Hunchback of Notre Dame* is named. In the earliest ritual books, today was known as White Sunday, the last Sunday of 'White Week' because of the white robes worn by those who had been baptized at the Easter Vigil. It was also known as the 'Dominica in Albis Deponendis', that is the Sunday



when the white robes of the neophytes would be discarded, and they would dress in normal Sunday clothes and be seated with the rest of the assembly.

It is in this spirit that I take this opportunity to say how proud I am of our eight neophytes (what we call the newly baptized) and our newly received members from other Christian traditions into that Catholic Church who totaled 33 in receiving the Sacraments of Initiation last week at our Easter Vigil. Though I have been fighting a bug, I have been positively glowing all week at being a part of that amazing experience.

In the early Church, when people were baptized they were held under the water until they were almost out of air, so that when they rose from the water they were gasping, breathing in a new life. It was beautiful to see the look on the faces of our neophytes as they emerged from the font of new life. I could tell that they were truly forever changed. Likewise those who were encountering Jesus Christ in the Eucharist for the first time and sealed with a gift to the Holy Spirit in the Sacrament of Confirmation, I could see a very visible change.

We are a different parish at Saint Elizabeth Seton. We had, in comparison to the huge parishes which surround us, smaller numbers this Easter. Yet, we had 33 people enter into the One True Church last weekend! We have about 300 children in our Faith Formation program -- a number which exceeds larger parishes in our area. Our little school is busting at the seams, we feed hundreds of families here every week. **Continued on pg 4.**



Our liturgy is full of beauty and richness. Our faith here is not stagnant. It is alive and active. We are in relationship with Christ Our Risen Lord.

Which brings me to the most recent name for this Sunday, that is **Divine Mercy Sunday**, based not only upon the mystical experience of St. Faustina in 1920-30s, but also on the readings and liturgical texts given us today. St. Thomas touches the side of Jesus from which blood and water flowed, long understood to be a sign of the sacramental life of the Church: Blood for the Holy Eucharist, water for the Font of Baptism. St. Thomas, in touching Jesus' side was moved from doubt to faith, and suddenly became aware of how loved he was even in his doubt. The Sacraments remind us of God's infinite mercy. **Conversation does not end with Baptism and Confirmation.** It is my prayer that the Mercy of Jesus will continue to transform us and that we never gaze at his Eucharistic Heart without falling to our knees and crying out, "My Lord and My God!"




For the sake of his sorrowful passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world!

OUR MOTHER OF GOOD COUNSEL STAINED GLASS; EAST SIDE OF CHURCH

We honor Mary in the Church under many titles. Augustinian devotion to Mary under the title of Our Mother of Good Counsel, celebrated on April 26, has its origin in the hill-town church of Genazzano, Italy, where the Augustinians have been located since the 13th Century.

We note the 'good counsel' of Mary in several scenes of the Gospel, especially that of Cana, when the mother of Jesus says, "Do whatever he tells you" (Jn. 2, 5). Saint Augustine reminds us that while Mary is blessed for being the mother of Jesus, she is even more blessed for being His disciple. The tender image of mother and child is at one and the same time so very human and so illustrative of a deep spiritual truth. In fact, as the first disciple of her son she presents Him to us as our teacher, our way, our truth and our life - even as He was for her. LA REFLEXIÓN DE PADRE CASEY

El segundo domingo de Pascua, último día de la Octava de Pascua, ha tenido diferentes nombres a lo largo de la historia de la Iglesia. Debido a la primera línea en la antífona de entrada en latín, que se refiere a los nuevos creyentes como bebés recién nacidos, hoy se conoce como el "Domingo de Quasimodo" por el cual se nombra al personaje principal en El jorobado de Notre Dame de Victor Hugo. En los libros rituales más antiguos, hoy se conocía como Domingo Blanco, el último domingo de la "Semana Blanca" debido a las túnicas blancas que vestían los que habían sido bautizados en la Vigilia Pascual. También era conocida como la 'Dominica in Albis Deponendis', es decir, el domingo en que se desechaban las túnicas blancas de los neófitos, se vestían con ropa normal de domingo y se sentaban con el resto de la asamblea.

Es en este espíritu que aprovecho esta oportunidad para decir lo orgulloso que estoy de nuestros ocho neófitos (lo que llamamos los recién bautizados) y nuestros miembros recibidos recientemente de otras tradiciones cristianas a la Iglesia Católica, sumando 33 en recibir los Sacramentos de Iniciación la semana pasada en nuestra Vigilia Pascual. Aunque he estado luchando contra una fiebre, he brillado positivamente toda la semana por ser parte de esa experiencia increíble.

En la Iglesia primitiva, cuando las personas eran bautizadas, se las mantenía bajo el agua hasta que casi se quedaban sin aire, de modo que cuando salían del agua estaban jadeando, respirando una nueva vida. Fue hermoso ver la mirada en los rostros de nuestros neófitos al salir de la fuente de la nueva vida. Me di cuenta de que realmente habían cambiado para siempre. Así mismo aquellos que se encontraban con Jesucristo en la Eucaristía por primera vez y sellados con un don al Espíritu Santo en el Sacramento de la Confirmación, pude ver un cambio muy visible.

Somos una parroquia diferente en Saint Elizabeth Seton. En comparación con las parroquias enormes que nos rodean, tuvimos números más pequeños esta Semana Santa. ¡Sin embargo, tuvimos 33 personas que ingresaron a la Única Iglesia Verdadera el fin de semana pasado! Tenemos alrededor de 300 niños en nuestro programa de Formación en la fé, un número que supera a las parroquias más grandes de nuestra área. Nuestra pequeña escuela está a punto de estallar, alimentamos a cientos de familias aquí cada semana. Nuestra liturgia está llena de belleza y riqueza. Nuestra fe aquí no está estancada. Está viva y activa. Estamos en una relación real con Cristo Nuestro Señor Resucitado.

Lo que me lleva al nombre más reciente de este domingo, que es Domingo de la Divina Misericordia, basado no solo en la experiencia mística de



An extraordinary exhibit of relics of the Saints will be touring the dioceses of Florida for the month of May. Father Carlos Martins, a Vatican-appointed expert on relics, will be here with a Vatican collection of over 160 relics, some as old as 2,000 years. Among the treasures will be relics of the Apostles, St. Mary Magdalene, St. Joseph, St. Maria Goretti, St. Therese of Lisieux, St. Francis of Assisi, St. Anthony of Padua, St. Thomas Aquinas, and St. Faustina Kowalska. There will also be a portion of the Veil of Our Lady and one of the largest remaining pieces of the True Cross in the world. Those in attendance will be able to examine and venerate each relic. Throughout history, many healings have been worked in the presence of relics; and thousands have occurred through this ministry. Do not miss this opportunity. You are encouraged to bring your articles of devotion (such as rosaries, holy cards, etc.) and pictures of ill friends/family members, which you will be able to touch to the reliquaries as a means of intercession. This is a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity. This exhibit will be at Seton on Thursday, May 12.
