

t the dawn of salvation history, God revealed our future in figures. That's what's going on in today's First Reading: a priest-king comes from Jerusalem (see Psalm 76:3), offering bread and wine to celebrate the victory of God's beloved servant, Abram, over his foes. By his offering, Melchizedek bestows God's blessings on Abram. He is showing us, too, how one day we will receive God's blessings and in turn "bless God"—how we will give thanks to Him for delivering us from our

enemies, sin and death. As Paul recalls in today's Epistle, Jesus transformed the sign of bread and wine, making it a sign of His body and blood, through which God bestows upon us the blessings of His "new covenant." Jesus is "the priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek," that God, in today's Psalm, swears will rule from Zion, the new Jerusalem (see Hebrews 6:20–7:3). By the miracle of loaves and fishes, Jesus in today's Gospel, again prefigures the blessings of the Eucharist.

Notice that He takes the bread, blesses it, breaks it, and gives it to the Twelve. You find the precise order and words in the Last Supper (see Luke 22:19) and in His celebration of the Eucharist on the first Easter night (see Luke 24:30).

The Eucharist fulfills the offering of Melchizedek. It is the daily miracle of the heavenly high priesthood of Jesus. It is a priesthood He conferred upon the Apostles in ordering them to feed the crowd, in filling exactly twelve baskets with leftover bread—in commanding them on the night He was handed over:

"Do this in remembrance of Me."

Through His priests He still feeds us in "the deserted place" of our earthly exile. And by this sign He pledges to us a glory yet to come. For as often as we share in His body and blood. we proclaim His victory over death, until He comes again to make His victory our own.

¿POR QUÉ CELEBRAMOS AL CORAZÓN DE JESÚS EN EL MES DE JUNIO?

La devoción al Sagrado Corazón de Jesús es una practica antigua. Podemos ver sus orígenes en las escrituras, en las propias referencias de Jesús sobre Su Corazón. "Vengan a mí, todos los que están cansados y agobiados y les daré descanso... porque soy manso

y humilde de corazón" (c.f. Mateo 11:28, 29)

La devoción obtuvo gran popularidad al finalizar los años 1600s. Jesús apareció varias veces a una hermana religiosa francesa, Santa Margarita Maria Alacoque, señalando su corazón. Durante este tiempo, la herejía del Jansenismo se había expandido en Francia, la cual predicaba predestinación limitada a la salvación. Cuando se le apareció a Margarita Maria, Jesús afirmaba su amor para toda la humanidad: "He aquí el Corazón que tanto ha amado a



los hombres, que no ha escatimado en nada". El pidió por una fiesta especial celebrando a Su Sagrado Corazón el viernes siguiente a la fiesta del Corpus Christi. A través del tiempo, junio es conocido como el mes del Sagrado Corazón. iPor favor, venga a la misa el viernes 24 de junio para celebrar la solemnidad del Sacratísimo Corazón de Jesús, 8am!





WHY DO WE CELEBRATE THE HEART OF JESUS IN THE MONTH OF JUNE?

Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is an ancient practice. We can see its Scriptural origins in Jesus' own references to His Heart. "Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest ... for I am meek and humble of

heart" (c.f. Matthew 11:28, 29).

The devotion received a surge of popularity in the late 1600s. Jesus appeared several times to a French religious sister, St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, pointing to his heart. During this time, the Jansenist heresy had risen in France, which preached limited predestination for salvation. When appearing to Margaret Mary, Jesus affirmed his love for all mankind: "Behold the Heart which has so loved men that it has spared nothing." He asked for a special feast celebrating his Sacred Heart on the Friday following the feast of Corpus Christi. Over time, June has become known as the month of Sacred Heart. Please come to Mass on Friday, June 24 to celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, 8am!
