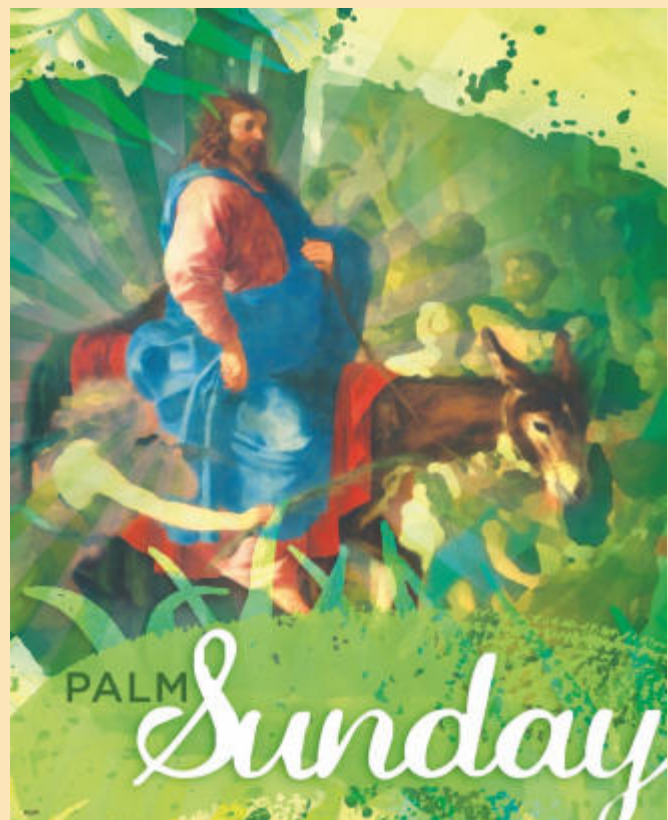

Two lesser meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted. This law binds Catholics who have completed their 18th year until the beginning of their 60th year.

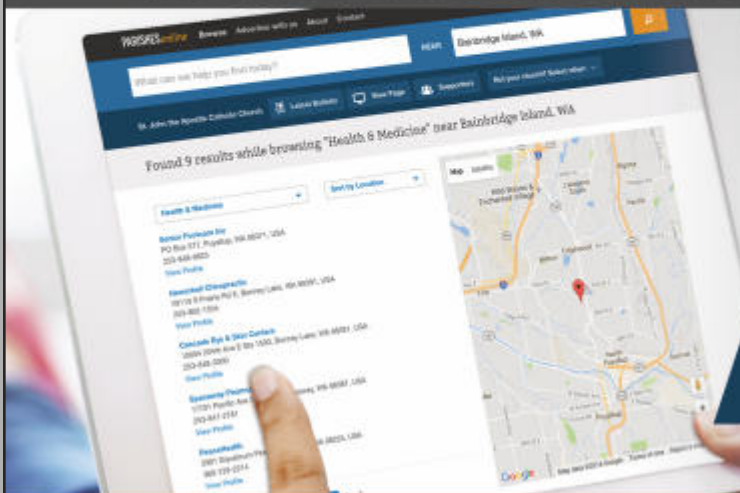
