Baptism: Registered Parishioners should contact the Parish Office

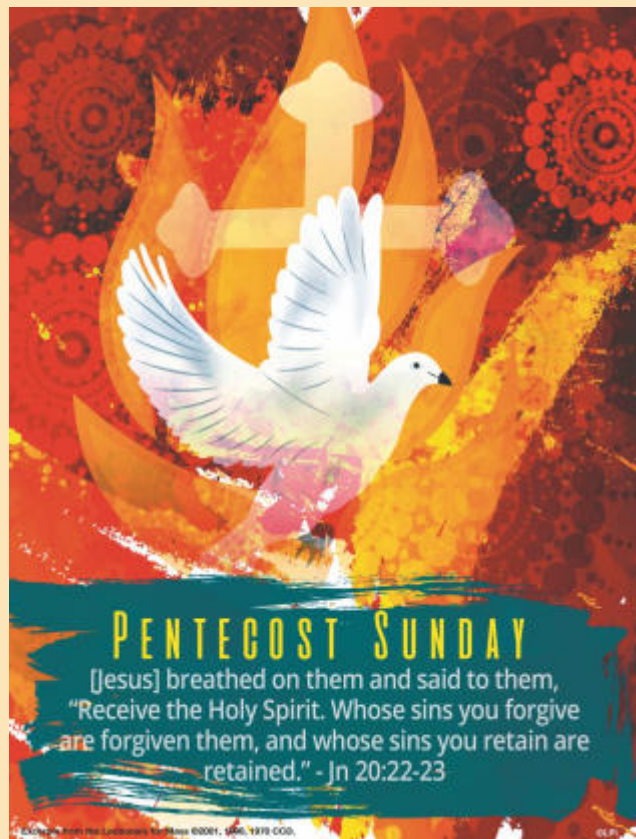
First Holy Communion, Reconciliation & Confirmation:
