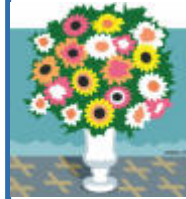

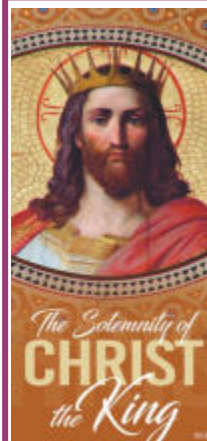

Dear Sacred Heart Family,

When most of us think of a parish, we naturally think of the church we attend on Sundays. This is not wrong at all, but the term “parish” is much more all-encompassing. In the Catholic Church, a parish is a portion of territory, which includes a particular population, a church, and a proper pastor. Every parish in every diocese has its own particular boundaries. Because of this, in years past, it was fairly easy to know what Catholics belonged to what parish. Whatever parish boundaries your address falls under, that was your parish.

However, as times changed, and people became more mobile and had more options, the Church in various countries (but especially in the US) began to implement the use of registration to know who the parishioners (especially active parishioners) of a given parish were.

Because many (if not most) people in most live outside the boundaries of their preferred parishes, registration is crucial for the pastor to know his flock. In addition to helping the parish keep better account of who its parishioners are, registration is of great importance to individual parishioners. Registration has an effect on many things for which people regularly approach their parish, including but not limited to the sacraments of initiation, annulments, religious education, etc.

Even more importantly, registration is essential because every Catholic needs a home. In an area such as ours, with many churches a relatively short distance away, it can be tempting to pick and choose where we go week to week, and never settle on a particular parish. But this is no different than moving houses every week or every month, rather than settling into a home. Just as we all need a physical home, we also need a spiritual home where we regularly spend time with our spiritual family.

If you regularly attend Holy Mass at Sacred Heart, I strongly urge you to register at your earliest convenience. In addition, if you know that you will soon be seeking particular services from the parish, please register. There are registration forms in the office and in the church. You are welcome to take one and return it to the office, mail it in, or simply place it in the collection basket. God bless you all!
