Dear Friends in Christ,

Today, we celebrate the completion of the Christmas mystery – the manifestation, or “Epiphany,” of the Lord Jesus to the world. The gentile world is represented by three astrologers, or wise men, from the East. These men are traditionally known by the names Caspar, Melchior, and Balthasar. Because these men brought gifts to Christ in His first home (the stable at Bethlehem), they have traditionally been invoked in the blessing of a home. Perhaps you have noticed on certain blessed homes and other buildings the following written using blessed chalk at the top of the doorway: 20+C+M+B+20. The writing recalls the year of the blessing, and the letters, the names of the three wise men. Another way to interpret the letters is as standing for the Latin words *Christus Mansionem Benedicat* (“May Christ bless this home”).

Just as those three wise men brought their most valuable gifts to Christ in the crib, so too are we called to bring ours. As we celebrate the 12th day of Christmas, we ask the intercession of Caspar, Melchior, and Balthasar, for ourselves, for our own homes and families, that we might spend this new year giving all of ourselves to the One Who gave us all of Himself.
