


Dear Friends in Christ,

This Sunday, we celebrate the Feast of the Lord's Baptism, which is essentially a continuation of His Epiphany – or manifestation. Although the Baptism that Jesus received was not the Sacrament of Baptism (of course, He had no need of it), it was the foreshadowing of it, as well as an anticipation and symbol of His future Passion and Death. Because of this, the Sacrament of Baptism allows us to experience through grace the mysteries of Jesus' Death and Resurrection. In the first volume of his great work, Jesus of Nazareth, Pope Benedict XVI comments on this event in the following way:

"Looking at the events [of Jesus' baptism] in light of the Cross and Resurrection, the Christian people realized what happened: Jesus unloaded the burden of all mankind's guilt upon His shoulders; He bore it down into the depths of the Jordan. He inaugurated His public activity by stepping into the place of sinners. His inaugural gesture is an anticipation of the Cross. He is, as it were, the true Jonah who said to the crew of the ship, '*Take me and throw me into the sea*' (Jonah 1:12). The whole significance of Jesus' Baptism, the fact that He bears 'all righteousness,' first comes to light on the Cross: The Baptism is an acceptance of death for the sins of humanity, and the voice that calls out '*This is my beloved Son*' over the baptismal waters is an anticipatory reference to the Resurrection. This also explains why, in His own discourses, Jesus uses the word *baptism* to refer to His own death (cf. Mark 10:38; Luke 12:50)."
