### St. John Bosco, Feast day January 31

John Melchior Bosco, born in 1815, popularly known as Don Bosco, was an Italian Roman Catholic priest, educator, and writer of the 19th century. While working in Turin, he dedicated his life to the education betterment and of street children. juvenile delinguents, and other disadvantaged youth. He developed teaching methods based on

love rather than punishment, a method that became known as the Salesian Preventive System. A follower of the spirituality and philosophy of St. Francis de Sales, Bosco was an ardent devotee of Mary, mother of Jesus, under the title Mary Help of Christians. He later founded the Salesians of Don Bosco, based in Turin. Saint John Bosco is the patron saint of apprentices, boys, editors, publishers, school children, the youth, and magicians. He earned and deserved the title, "Father and Teacher of Youth." Died on January 31. 1888. "I want to give you the formula for sanctity; first, be happy; second, study and pray; third, do good to everyone." Saint John Bosco, pray for us!

Dear Sacred Heart Family,

This week is observed throughout the United States as Catholic Schools Week. As Catholic parishes, the school is our primary means of evangelization. It is in passing the Faith on to the next generation that we heed the call of Christ. The Church desires that every child receive a Catholic education, and that happens primarily in Catholic schools. The Catholic school system that we know today owes its origin largely to the efforts of the first American saint – St Elizabeth Ann Seton. Mother Seton converted to Catholicism after the death of her husband, and raised her five children as a widow. As she was educating her own children, she was called upon by Catholic priests and bishops to help with the education of other Catholic children in rural Maryland. The religious order that she founded, the Sisters of Charity of St Joseph, were the first religious community founded in the United States, and the first of countless orders of teaching sisters that were all modeled upon Mother Seton's community. We ask her intercession, especially for Charleston Catholic School, for our faculty, staff, students, and parents. God bless you all!
