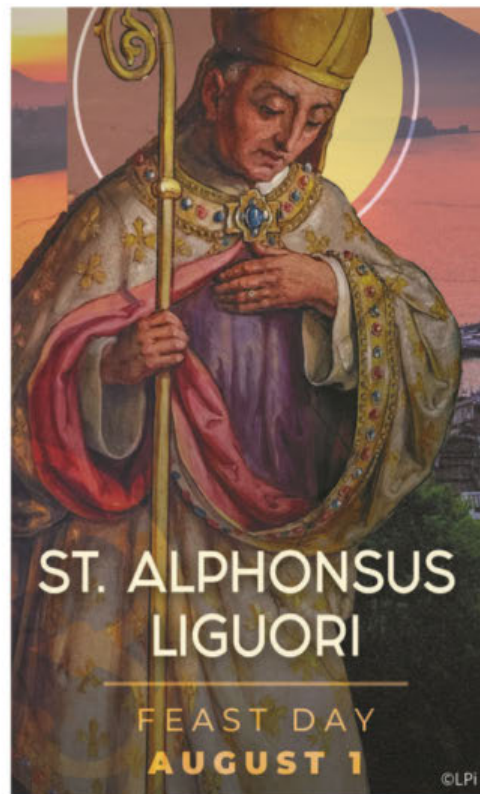

Inspiration for the week

Greed is more present and powerful in our lives than we care to admit. We like our "stuff" and are hesitant to part with it. What we convince ourselves that we really need, we really do not. If everything we own is taken away from us tomorrow, life will continue. We will find happiness again. How many relationships are ruined because of inheritance issues? Our possessions cannot come with us when we die. Why do we foolishly think that we cannot live without them here? Wealth and happiness do not have physical origins. True wealth and happiness are gifts of God's kingdom and matters of heart and soul. We are much more than what we possess, and greed is more real and operative than we think. Let us begin our journey to detachment with an honest admission. We often place more importance on things than on people and God. Ask God to accept our conflicted hearts and give us the courage to do things differently.



SAINT OF THE WEEK

Saint Alphonsus was born into a well-respected family in 1696, in Marianella, in the Kingdom of Naples. He received an exceptional education through private tutors and was conferred degrees in civil and canon law at 16. He practiced law for 8 years before he turned to the Church. He was ordained a priest in 1726.

Saint Alphonsus traveled for 26 years in Kingdom of Naples preaching. His style of ministry was called "mission among the people," he and a group of priests or lay brothers would go to rural areas, staying for a time to teach, preach, and pray with the people there.

Saint Alphonsus was a brilliant preacher, he was able to connect with ordinary people and his teaching and sermons were marked by his compassion. In a time of restrictive Church rule, where fear of God was truly fear, Saint Alphonsus taught about God's redeeming love. He also had a special devotion to Mary, praying to her for intercession and including devotions to her in his teaching. He wrote extensively, more than 100 books which have been through thousands of editions. His books are still available today and have been translated into more than 60 languages.

In 1762 Saint Alphonsus was made a bishop by Pope Clement XIII, however, he was eventually allowed to resign his post because of his ill health. He was paralyzed for a time from rheumatic fever in 1775, and had rheumatism so severe it was deforming, bending his head so far forward that his chin rested on his chest.

He died peacefully at the age of 90 in 1787. He was canonized in 1839 by Pope Gregory XVI, and in 1871 he was named a doctor of the church by Pope Pius IX. In 1950 he was declared patron of moral theologians by Pope Pius XII.

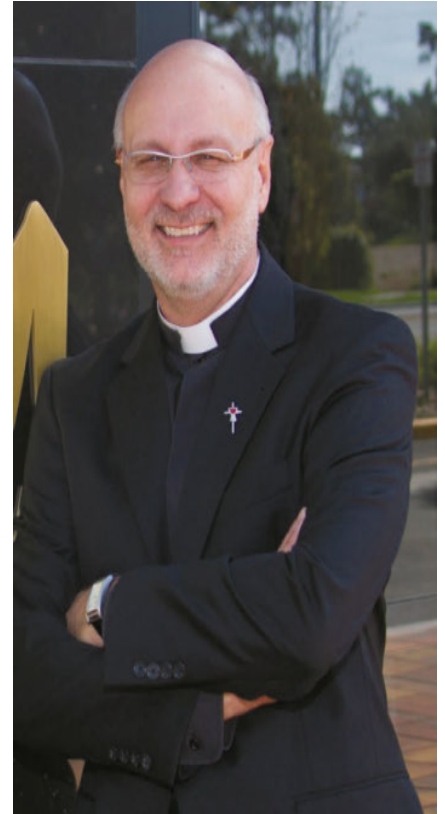
Meet Our New Pastor

Rev. Benjamin Berinti, CPP.S. is a Missionary of the Most Precious Blood and currently serves as Pastor of Immaculate Conception Church in Melbourne Beach. Rev. Berinti will be serving our St. Joseph Parish as of August 1st.

In his nearly 37 years of priestly ministry, Fr. Ben has served as a university professor of religion and humanities; Dean of Catholic Campus Ministry at the University of Central Florida; on the pastoral team at the San Pedro Spiritual Center; co-director of Lay Ecclesial Ministry formation; and parish pastor. Fr. Ben has ministered in the Diocese of Orlando for over 25 years.

A well-respected teacher, retreat leader, pastor, author and theologian, Fr. Ben writes for the *Florida Catholic's* Sunday Word column; works with Catholic radio programming on WDMC; teaches with the Loyola University New Orleans Institute for Ministry; and has written three collections of spiritual essays, as well as three hand-made limited edition spiritual chapbooks.

In his spare time, he serves as Vice-Provincial of the Cincinnati Province of his religious congregation, Vicar for Religious in our Diocese, and as a member of the Orlando Diocese Priests' Council.

MEET OUR NEW PRECIOUS BLOOD MISSIONARIES



Fr. Raymond Kaele, C.P.P.S. 42, comes to us from the African nation of Tanzania. He arrived in the U.S. July 8 along with another CPPS Missionary priest, who will be serving in Dayton, OH. Fr. Raymond was ordained in 2013, and has served as his province's vocations director and in provincial administration. He has also ministered at St. Gaspar Hospital and was the director of the Missionaries' Radio Mwangaza in Dodoma. He was most recently in ministry at the Catholic parish located at Dodoma University.

Fr. Tim Knepper, C.P.P.S. is a Missionary of the Precious Blood of the United States Province. In addition, he is also a Missionary of Mercy. Fr. Tim is a "full communion Catholic" having joined from the conservative Baptist tradition. A priest for 19 years, Fr. Tim has served as a parochial vicar throughout his priesthood and now is receiving training as a spiritual director. His hobbies include walking, listening to podcasts, visiting museums, and now being in Florida, seeing all the natural beauty. Fr. Tim says he looks forward to being parochial vicar here at St. Joseph's in Palm Bay and here at ICC.



Fr. Frankline Rayappa, C.P.P.S. is originally from south India, called Chennai. He was ordained into the Precious Blood community on February 17th, 2007 and began his priestly ministry in India for the first eight years—six as a pastor and correspondent of the school for grades K through 10, and the last two as administrator of a retreat center. In 2016, he came to the United States for the first time and served as an associate pastor, at St. Edward Catholic Church, Newark, CA until 2018. For the past four years, he has been pastor of St. Augustine Catholic Church, in Minster, OH.

Fr. Frankline wrote: "I look forward to meeting all of you and learning the wonders of your life and faith stories. Thank you for your openness to welcome me into these great communities of faith as your priest, spiritual brother, and friend In Christ."

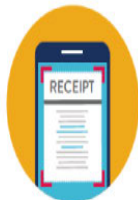
