

A Lot Can Happen In Seven Days



Dear St. Matthew's family,

The coming Sunday is Palm Sunday, and we are entering, through liturgical rites, the last days of the life of Jesus. I invite you to join us for the Holy Week. We begin the Holy Week by commemorating Christ's Messianic entrance into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday and the PASCHAL TRIDUUM, the most solemn of three days in the whole liturgical year, the special liturgies of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, The Easter Vigil, and Easter Sunday.

It's time to get ready for a blessed journey with Jesus: from the highways of Jerusalem on Palm Sunday, to the loving touch through the washing of feet, the "last supper" of Holy Thursday, to Golgotha and the anguish of the cross on Good Friday. Finally, to the empty tomb on Easter morning, to hear the astonishing and jubilant announcement that "Christ is Risen!" Our Holy Week worship provides an opportunity to experience the fullness of God's sacrificial and triumphant love for us and the world through the story of Jesus.

Like the crowds that followed Jesus during His lifetime on earth, we must choose for ourselves what His message, and the meaning of His life, have to do with our lives.

Like Peter and His other disciples, will we run away, desert him, reject him, stand with him, cry for his crucifixion, or just walk away and hide in the safe place? Since last we commemorated Holy Week, our lives are the answer to these questions. But, even if we, like Peter, our leader, might have cause to weep bitterly, we know that we are still loved and forgiven.

I look forward to celebrating this Holy Week with you. Let us keep each other in our prayers, especially those who cannot make it for various reasons.

"We adore you, O Christ, and we bless you because, by your Holy Cross, you have redeemed the world."

I wish all of you a grace-filled Holy Week.
