Training Sessions for new Lectors and Eucharistic Ministers

There will be 2 workshops for new Lectors and new Eucharistic Ministers on Monday, May 9th and Tuesday, May 10th in the church. Eucharistic Ministers at 6:00 pm and Lectors at 7:00 pm both days.

Anyone who is interested in joining either or both of these vital and rewarding ministries should plan to attend one of the workshops.

Did you know that our church is the only church in NE Florida that has a loop system? What is a loop system? Basically, it's a wire that surrounds the church, under the floor, and transmits all sound from the audio system electromagnetically. If you have a hearing aid, or a cochlear implant, AND you have a telecoil, all you have to do is switch that T-coil on to activate it. Your hearing aid will then pick up that electromagnetic signal and you will hear the Father, Deacons and the choir right in your ears! You do not need to wear any headphones or earbuds with a receiver. If you are not sure if you have a telecoil, ask your audiologist or the hearing specialist that sold the hearing aid to you. If you don't wear a hearing aid, but still need some help hearing, you can still use a loop receiver with headphones or ear buds. We have them in the sacristy. Even these loop receivers allow you to hear the music and spoken words more clearly than the old FM receivers. If you have any questions, please contact the church office and we will put you in contact with Laura Terrebonne with Hearing Loss Association of America.
