

## Pastoral Sharing January 9, 2022 The Baptism of the Lord

Today we celebrate the feast of the Baptism of the Lord. In today's gospel, (Luke 3;15-16, 21-22) as in the other gospel accounts of Jesus's Baptism, we hear John the Baptist address the confusion of the people who thought that John might be the messiah. In response, John contrasts the baptism that he performs with the baptism that Jesus will inaugurate. John the Baptist says that he has baptized with water, but that some one will come and baptize with the Holy Spirit. The type of baptism that John performed was not yet a Christian baptism; it was a preparation for the Christian baptism through which sins are forgiven and the gift of the Holy Spirit is received.


Today's gospel from Luke marks a change in focus from the ministry of John the Baptist to that of Jesus. John himself knows his place. He is unworthy to help Jesus take off his sandals. John also knows the difference between the baptism each can perform. John baptizes with water, a common practice at that time, but Jesus will baptize with the Holy Spirit and fire. Jesus's Baptism will be greater than John's.


In the second part of the gospel we have a statement about all the people John baptized, including Jesus. On the basis of this statement, Jesus's baptism appears to be just like everyone else's. However, we see Jesus praying and we hear of the Holy Spirit coming upon Jesus from heaven. Finally a voice from identifies Jesus as " my beloved son ".

Jesus's baptism by John was the same as everyone else's. But it led to something entirely different. His baptism would mark the beginning of new period in his life. Interestingly, Luke places the genealogy of Jesus immediately after his baptism. Following the genealogy is the story of Jesus's temptation in the desert. Luke begins the temptation narrative noting that Jesus returns from the Jordan filled with the Holy Spirit. The Spirit never leaves Him throughout His journey to Jerusalem, and empowers him to fulfill his mission.

The spirit we receive at baptism does the same for us. Through the Spirit and through frequent prayer modeled on Jesus's prayer, we draw closer to God as God's beloved sons and daughters.


