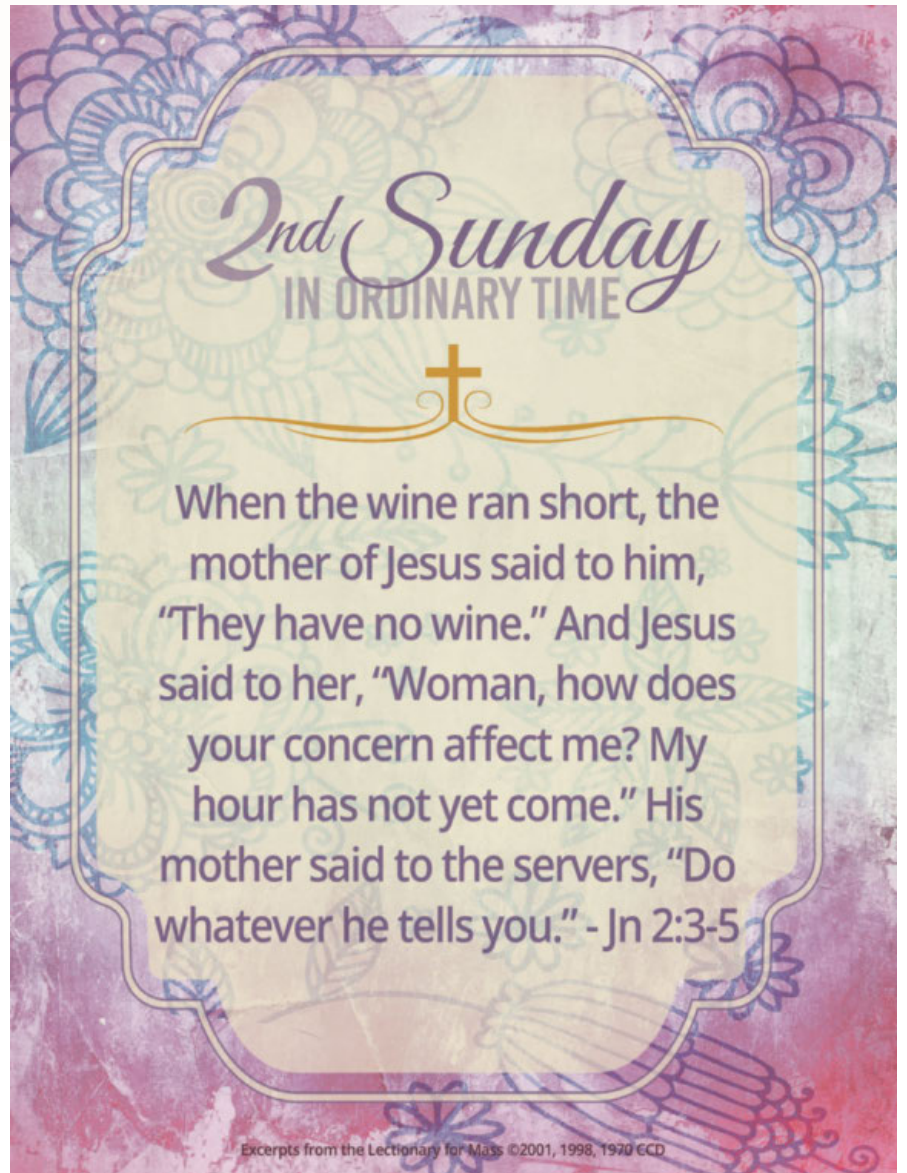

Pastoral Sharing
January 16, 2022
2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

In today's Gospel reading (JN 2:4-11), we have the beginning of Jesus's ministry and his first miracle at a wedding feast in Cana. The story of changing water into wine is found only in the Gospel of John. John's purpose in recording the events of Cana is far larger than a casual interest in a wedding feast or in the miraculous changing of water into wine. Perhaps the best way to understand this reading is to recall the text of an antiphon from the feast of Epiphany: "Three mysteries mark this holy day: today the star leads the magi to the infant Christ; today water is changed into wine for the wedding feast; today Christ wills to be baptized by John in the river Jordan to bring us salvation".

These three events mark the appearance that is the manifestation, the Epiphany, of Jesus inaugurating his divine mission on earth. Each is accompanied by a theophany – startling evidence of divine intervention: the star, the water into wine, the voice from heaven and the dove. The point of the story of the wedding at Cana, then, belongs to John's body of evidence that this Jesus truly is the son of God and the bringer of God's redeeming love.

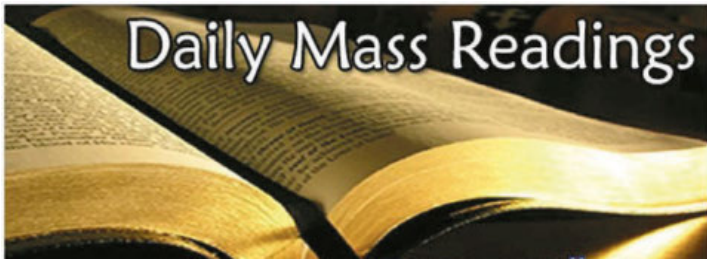
Like the rest of John's account, the Cana story is layered with levels of theological meaning. Water for Old Testament ceremonial washings changes into superabundant wine, symbolizing the dawn of the messianic age, and even prefiguring Christ's passion. As here water is changed into wine, wine will eventually change into blood, the new means of purification. So in a sense, Calvary starts at Cana. When Jesus tells Mary his "hour" has not yet come, he uses a word that in John always refers to his passion. The miracle at Cana is the first of the "signs" that manifest Jesus's glory: his death on the cross.

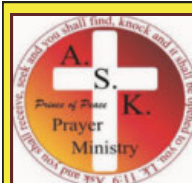
