## NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

My brothers and sisters,

We hear this weekend the response that all of us share ***“Here am I, Lord. I come to do Your will.”*** It is stated in Psalm 40, ***“I have waited, waited for the Lord and He stooped toward me and heard my cry. And He put a new song into my mouth, a hymn to our God..., in the written scroll it is prescribed for me, to do you will, O my God, is my delight, and Your law is within my heart!”*** We have concluded the season of Christmas and enter into a new time renewed by faith that God is with us; we pursue fulfilling God’s will as a people.

The call that each of us has to do God’s will is contextualized in the second reading in 1 Corinthians chapter 6 as it is said, ***“Do you not know that your bodies are members of Christ?...Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you...Therefore glorify God in your body.”*** Pursuing a new endeavor that results in spiritual benefits like holiness and sanctification is the greatest manifestation of what God would want for us, His children. Is that not what you want for your own children or the ones you love; that they could be wholly satisfied, pure of heart and fulfilling a greater purpose for their lives? Yes, indeed, we can see that these realities are the most sublime, and what we as Catholics believe is attainable by the divine assistance God provides through Jesus Christ His Son.

It is John the Baptist in this weekend’s Gospel who says in his own words, ***“Behold, the Lamb of God.”*** Clearly, God provides His son Jesus Christ and the grace He establishes in a holy covenant in His blood that He truly removes, not only our personal sin, but the sin of the whole world. Therefore, we must make it our constant duty as Christian brothers and sisters to pursue holiness, to be sanctified by the mercy of Jesus Christ in the sacrament of reconciliation to fulfill God’s will, to be purified in heart and to have hands that are clean.

“Now the Lord has spoken who formed me as His servant from the womb...” Let us be His servants and express as a people: ***“HERE AM I LORD, I COME TO DO YOUR WILL.” ALLELUIA AMEN ALLELUIA***






## OFFERTORY UPDATE:

Compared to the same quarter prior year (Q4'2019) contributions decreased overall due to lower than normal church attendance due to COVID-19. However, Online Giving has increased significantly as people have shifted to online giving through WeShare since March 2020.

Compared to the previous quarter (Q3'2020) overall contributions increased by 24%, lead by an increase of 60% in debt reduction.



# LIVING OUR FAITH

## WHY DO WE DO THAT?

### Question:


**Why do parishes have the Blessed Sacrament in a separate room?**

### Answer:

While many Catholics of a certain age have memories of the Blessed Sacrament being housed in the tabernacle on the high altar of the church, many parishes in the decades since the Second Vatican Council have chosen to build a separate space — a reservation chapel — where the Blessed Sacrament is kept. Although this practice is not universal, it is in keeping with the guidance offered by the US Bishops in their document *Built of Living Stones* (see nos 77-78). The goal is to create a space that is separated from the nave and sanctuary, but which is “integrally connected with the church” which can foster “reverence and can provide the quiet and focus needed for personal prayer.” This can be especially important for communities that have continuous eucharistic adoration, allowing people to come and pray in a space separate from the normal activities of parish life.

The practice of reserving the Eucharist in a separate space — or in a dignified location away from the altar where Mass is celebrated — is that it emphasizes the importance of the liturgy itself, which is the “source and summit” of the life of the Church.

As with many things in the Church, the practice of placing the tabernacle in the sanctuary or in a separate chapel is not universal (as can be seen in visits to historic churches in Rome and other places). The important thing is that as communities question where to place the tabernacle, they listen to the voice of the Church, explore the ancient and varied liturgical tradition of the Church, consider the needs and life of the community, and also take into account the architecture and limits of the spaces they might already have.


