REFLECTION

SAINT JOHN PAUL II — FEAST DAY OCTOBER 22ND

Karol Józef Wojtyła was born in Wadowice, Poland. During World War II, during oppressive Nazi occupation, Karol enrolled in an underground seminary in Kraków. After the war ended, Karol was ordained a priest in 1946. He was sent for further education in Rome.

Karol was appointed as an auxiliary bishop of Kraków in 1958. He attended sessions of the Second Vatican Council and contributed significantly to the ecumenical discussion. The experience of the council changed him and deepened his commitment to renewing the Church. He was named archbishop of Kraków in 1964, elevated to a cardinal in 1967, and provided leadership to the faithful of Poland as they faced persecution under Communist rule.

When Pope Paul VI died on August 6th, 1978, Wojtyła went to Rome to elect a new pope. The cardinals elected Cardinal Albino Luciani, who took the name John Paul. When Pope John Paul died after 33 days in office, the cardinals gathered once again, and this time, they elected Wojtyła, who took the name John Paul II. He was the first non-Italian elected as Supreme Pontiff in 455 years. When he stepped out onto the balcony facing St. Peter's Square, his first words were these: "Be not afraid! Open up—no, swing wide the gates to Christ. Open up to his saving power the confines of the state, open up economic and political systems, the vast empires of culture, civilization and development... Be not afraid!"

Among his many accomplishments as pope, he made 104 apostolic journeys outside Italy and promulgated a new catechism. He inaugurated World Youth Day and the World Meeting of Families. "It is Jesus that you seek when you dream of happiness," he told young people in the year 2000. "He is waiting for you when nothing else you find satisfies you; he is the beauty to which you are so attracted.... It is he who reads in your hearts your most genuine choices, the choices that others try to stifle."

John Paul II died on April 2^{nd} , 2005. Pope John Paul II was beatified in 2011 and was canonized a saint on April 27^{th} , 2014, along with Pope John XXIII.





On December 12th, 2021 we will be celebrating the feast of Our Lady Of Guadalupe with Mass and a celebration to follow.


