REFLECTION

WORDS OF WISDOM FROM OUR BLESSED MOTHER

"His mother said to the servers, 'Do whatever he tells you." John 2:5

This short and direct statement from our Blessed Mother says all we need to know. "Do whatever He tells you." What else do we need to know in life? The hard part, of course, is following that advice. It's easy to believe it and to preach it, but it's another thing to follow through and fulfill His divine will.

That short exhortation calls us to discern what Jesus wants of us and to freely embrace that which we discern. How are you doing in these two areas?

First of all, discerning the will of God can be hard in the sense that it requires a wholehearted attentiveness to His gentle voice. God does not impose His will on us; rather, He respectfully and quietly invites us to listen. He waits until we give Him our full attention and then reveals His will one step at a time. Yes, some things have been made clear already through public revelation such as the avoidance of sin and the embrace of faith, hope and love. But when we are ready to let those general commands enter practically into our daily lives, we must be ready to give God our full attention.

Second, we should realize that God's will, when properly discerned, is not always easy to embrace. He requires everything of us. He is a "jealous God" in the sense that He wants our total surrender. The good news is that if we are willing to give Him everything in total obedience, we will discover that our lives are completely fulfilled. If you are ready for this, you are on the path toward holiness. *mycatholic.life*





"WELL DONE, GOOD AND FAITHFUL SERVANT" —MATT 25:23

Msgr. Daniel Bernard Logan, a leader in the Diocese of St. Augustine, went home to the Lord on Dec. 27, 2021. He was 83.

He was born on Feb. 3, 1938, in County Kildare, Ireland, to Peter Logan and Ellen Hynan Logan, and he had two brothers, John Joseph and Thomas Patrick. Following his ordination to the priesthood in 1963, Logan was recruited to serve in the Diocese of St. Augustine, Fla., by Archbishop Joseph P. Hurley. His first parish assignment was assistant pastor at St. Paul's in Riverside (1963-1967). He also served as assistant pastor at Sacred Heart Parish, Jacksonville (1968-1970), pastor at St. John the Baptist Parish, Atlantic Beach (1970-1974), the founding pastor of Holy Family Parish,



Jacksonville (1974-1999) and pastor of Our Lady Star of the Sea Parish, Ponte Vedra Beach retiring from full-time ministry in 2013.

In addition to his parish duties, Msgr. Logan had a long and influential career in Catholic education. He began teaching religion at Bishop Kenny High School in 1965. Two years later, Msgr. Logan earned a master's degree in religious education before being appointed the school's vice-president in 1968. In 1971, Bishop Paul Tanner named the 33-year-old priest president, serving the school until 1989. As pastor of Our Lady Star of the Sea, Msgr. Logan opened Palmer Catholic Academy, which educates students in pre-kindergarten through 8th grade.

Since 1974, along with his duties as president of Bishop Kenny and pastor of a growing parish, Holy Family, Msgr. Logan was part of a weekly panel of religious leaders in Jacksonville on the television program "For Heaven's Sake," airing on Sundays at 7 a.m. on WJXT-TV. His media talents also included a regular "Question & Answer" column for Community, a diocesan sponsored page in the Florida Times-Union and Gainesville Sun newspapers. He also wrote for the St. Augustine Catholic magazine and served as a key spokesperson for the diocese with local news media.

Msgr. Logan was a humble and humorous man passionate about his vocation as a priest. He was a man who lived his faith daily, modeling God's teachings.
