


TRIDUUM SCHEDULE

FROM THE EVENING OF HOLY THURSDAY TO THE EVENING OF EASTER SUNDAY

The summit of the Liturgical Year is the Easter Triduum. Though chronologically three days, they are liturgically one day unfolding for us the unity of Christ's Paschal Mystery.

The single celebration of the Triduum marks the end of the Lenten season and leads to the Mass of the Resurrection of the Lord at the Easter Vigil. The liturgical services that take place during the Triduum are: **Good Friday of the Lord's Passion – April 15, 3:00pm**, Veneration of the Cross

Holy Saturday – April 16, 9:00pm, Easter Vigil

EASTER SUNDAY – April 17, Mass of the Resurrection of the Lord: Sunrise Mass at 6:00am (outside) Masses at 8:00am & 10:00am will be inside.

Holy Thursday – April 14, 7:00pm, Mass of the Lord's Supper

Overflow seating & livestream of Mass will be outside.

PLEASE NOTE SCHEDULE CHANGES FOR HOLY WEEK AND EASTER

There will be no daily Masses during Holy Week. Please join us for the Celebration of the Triduum.

We will have Morning Prayer Thursday, Friday, & Saturday at 8:30am.

There will be no Adoration on Wednesday, April 13. There will be no Confessions on Holy Saturday, April 16.

The Parish Office will be closed on Good Friday, April 15, and Monday, April 18 through Wednesday, April 20 the first week of Easter.




