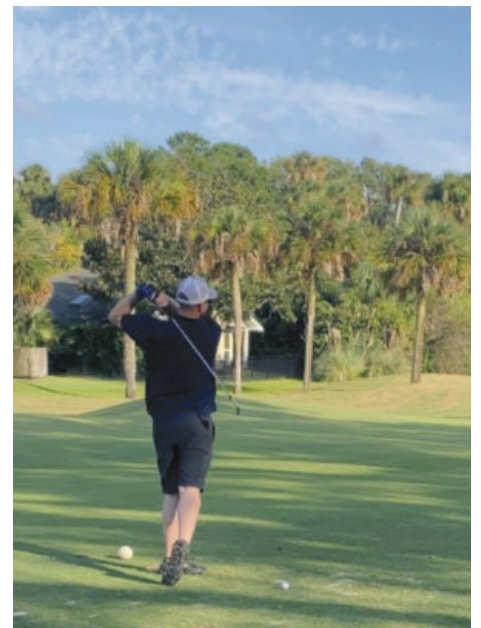
You are invited to the Second Annual St. John Paul II Catholic Church Golf Tournament on **Friday, September 16** at The Yards in Ponte Vedra!

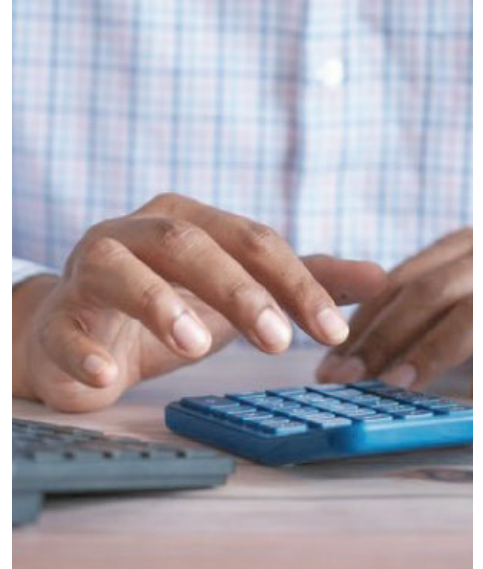

MINISTRY OF CONSOLATION PRAYER SHAWL PROGRAM

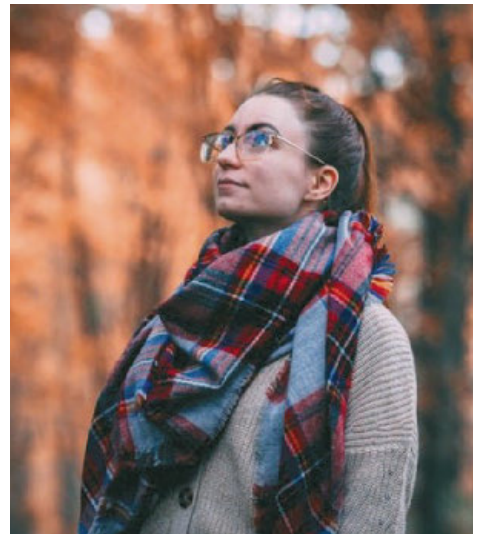
