



# What Is It?

RCIA, The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults, offers the opportunity to come together in a group setting to learn more about the Catholic Faith.

Together with catechists and sponsors, candidates explore elements of the Catholic faith as sessions focus on the teachings, traditions and experiences of the Catholic Church. Candidates attend other special activities and retreats throughout the year. Classes are held at St. John Paul II Church.

# **PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN**

Persons in our community who are young, mentally or physically challenged, or elderly make up the most vulnerable persons subject to abuse. PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN is an interactive workshop designed to provide information in order to recognize concerning behavior and provide participants with definitive steps for intervention when warranted to protect persons at risk.

Any adult who desires to work or volunteer within the Archdiocese with at risk persons is required to complete the Protecting God's Children workshop and submit to a background/fingerprint check.
