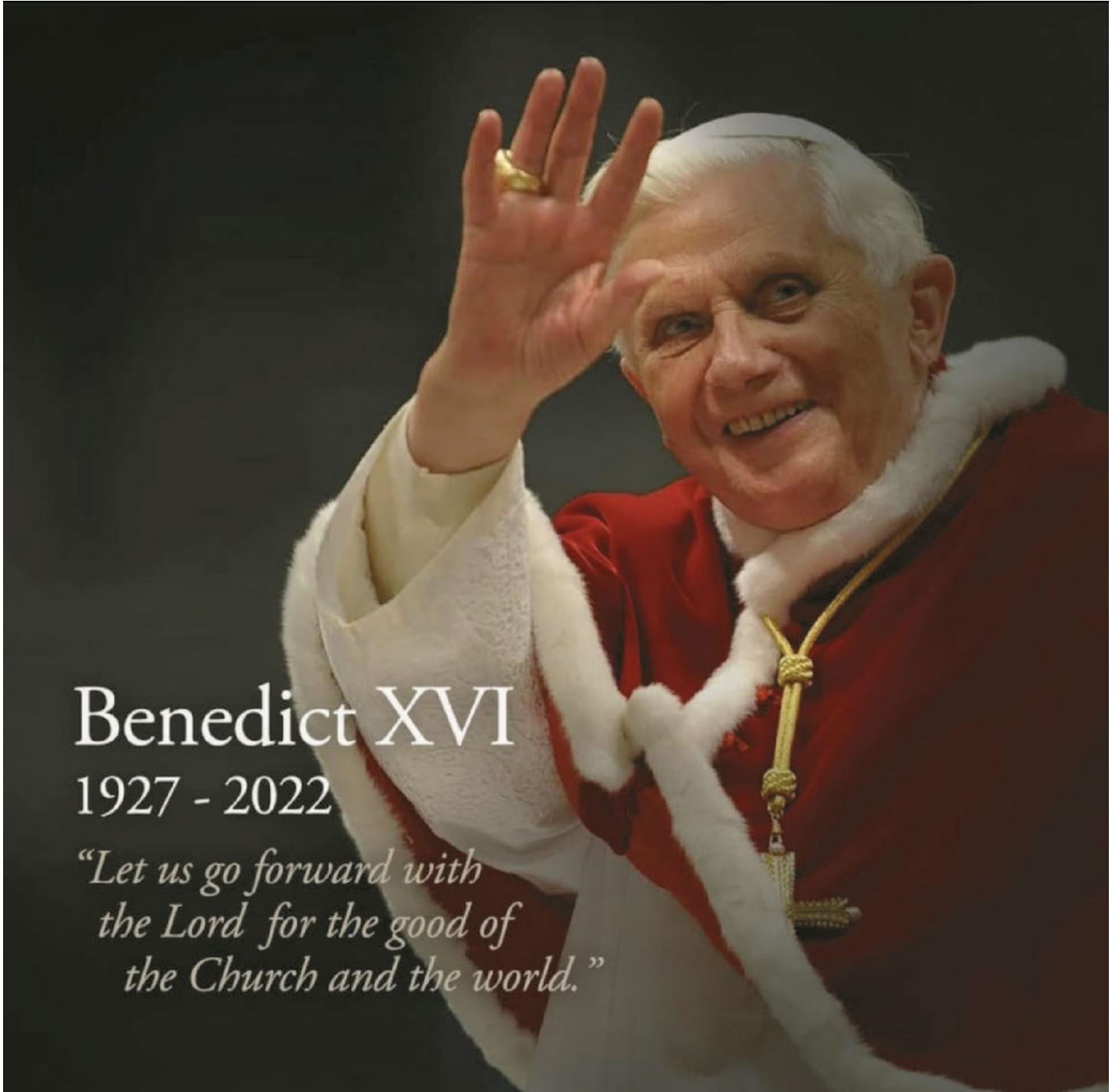

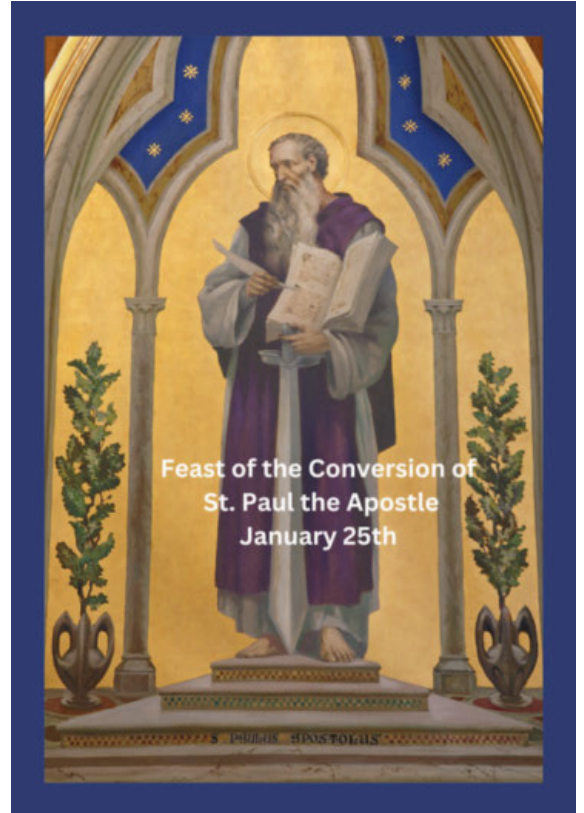

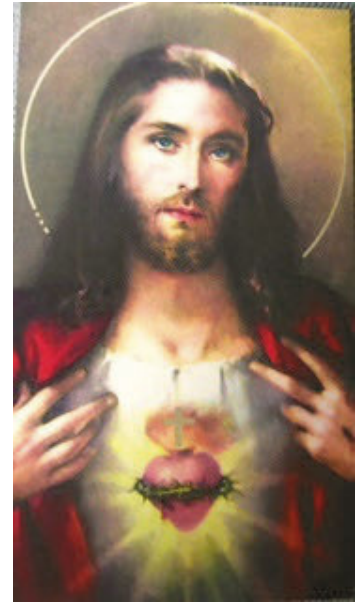
HONORING THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS

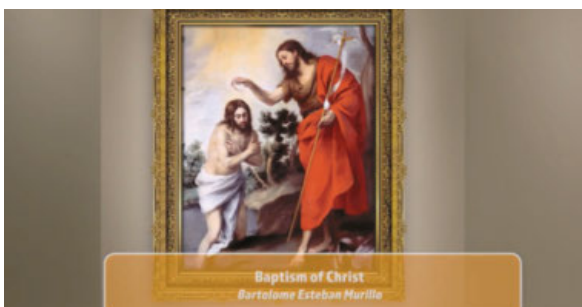
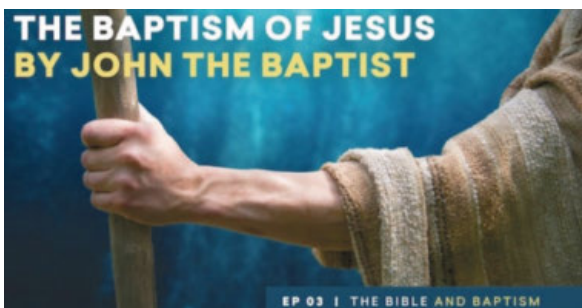

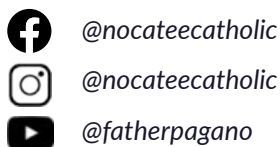
