



Cost is \$50/table of 6-8: \$10/individual.



GOOD FRIDAY

SPJII Good Friday services include Morning Prayer at 8:30 a.m. followed with The Passion of Our Lord and the Veneration of the Cross at 3 p.m. Families can use the day to focus on its meaning. The SPJII Knights of Columbus encourages parishioners to plan for the Good Friday liturgy April 7th. Please note this on your calendar, request time off from work if possible, and attend this solemn and important celebration with your family. This high holy day is the key to our faith.




