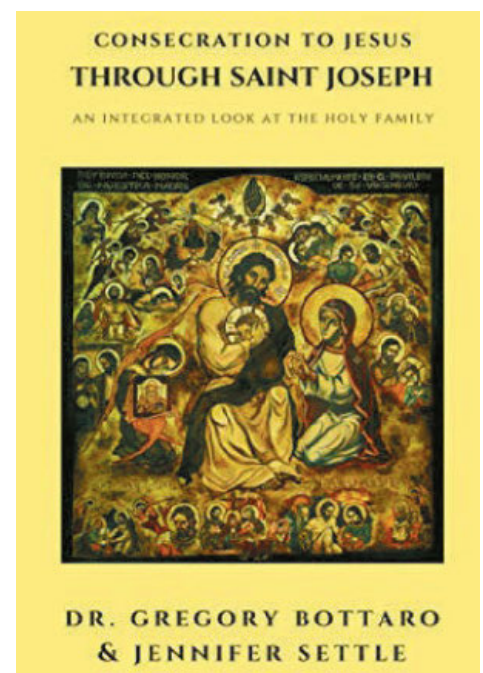
44-DAY CONSECRATION TO JESUS THROUGH ST. JOSEPH

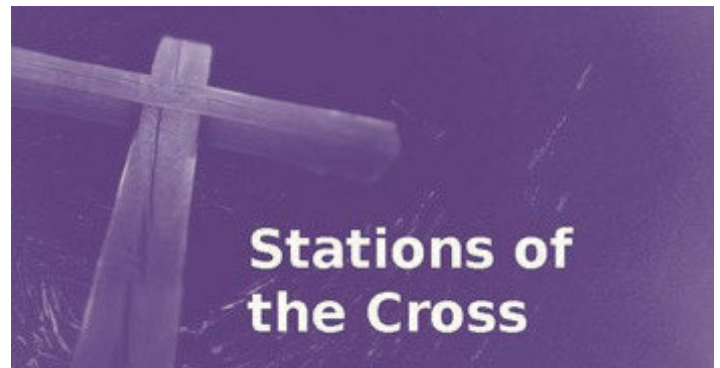

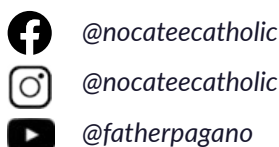
