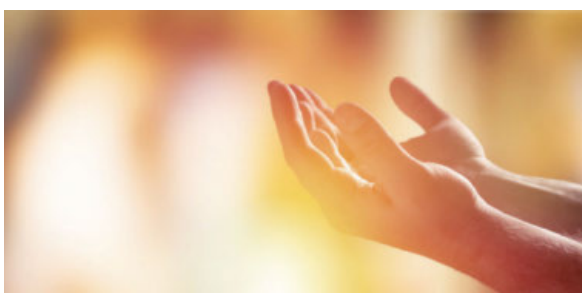

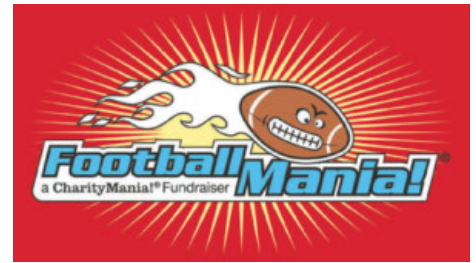

DECLINE TO SIGN PETITIONS FOR DANGEROUS PRO-ABORTION BALLOT INITIATIVES

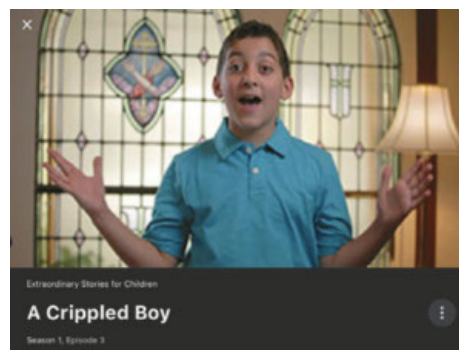
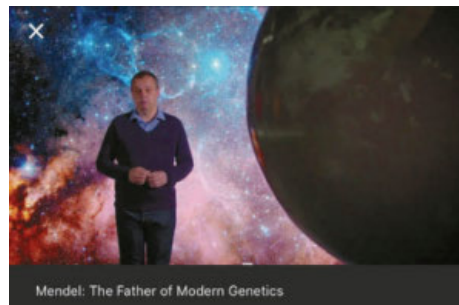
Parishioners and Friends of SJPII, the Florida Conference of Catholic Bishops want to express their grave concern and disapproval of a pro-abortion ballot initiative currently ongoing in our state. Pro-abortion activists are seeking to collect 900,000 signatures to put a statewide question on the November 2024 ballot that, if approved, would allow abortion up to birth and wipe out other pro-life protections in Florida. 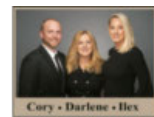

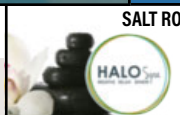
