SAN LORENZO RUIZ FEST


COME CELEBRATE SAN LORENZO RUIZ AND THE FILIPINO CULTURE AT SJPII!!

Everyone is invited to attend the Feast Day Celebration of San Lorenzo Ruiz, the first Filipino saint, on **Sunday, September 24th during and following the 12:00pm Mass**. Come enjoy music, dancing, singing, and amazingly delicious food of the Philippines. **Free for everyone and ALL are welcome.**

ADORATION

First Friday Devotion consists of attending Holy Mass on the first Fridays of nine consecutive months and receiving Holy Communion in a state of grace and in reparation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. What does "in a state of grace" mean? This means confessing any mortal sin before receiving Holy Communion. And what does "in reparation" mean? It means having the intention of love for Jesus, especially for all those who do not love Him, for the pain our sins and the sins of the world have caused His Heart, and for those who do not appreciate the Gift of Jesus' True Presence in the Most Holy Eucharist.

First Saturday Devotion consists of fulfilling the following practices for five consecutive first Saturdays: going to confession within 8 days of first Saturday, attending Holy Mass and receiving Holy Communion in a state of grace, praying five decades of the Holy Rosary, and meditating for 15 minutes on the mysteries of the Rosary. Our parish encourages these devotions and adds a special opportunity of 24-hours of Adoration between these two morning Masses, in order that we might spend time with Our Lord in reparation to His Most Sacred Heart.

However, in October, the hours of Adoration have been changed to Thursday evening, starting at 8pm, through Friday morning at 8am, prior to first Friday Mass at 8:30am. We will return to our normal hours for 24-hour Adoration in November. The sign up is available above for October and November. Please sign up for a Holy Hour if you are able, but all are welcome to come to pray at any time! 
