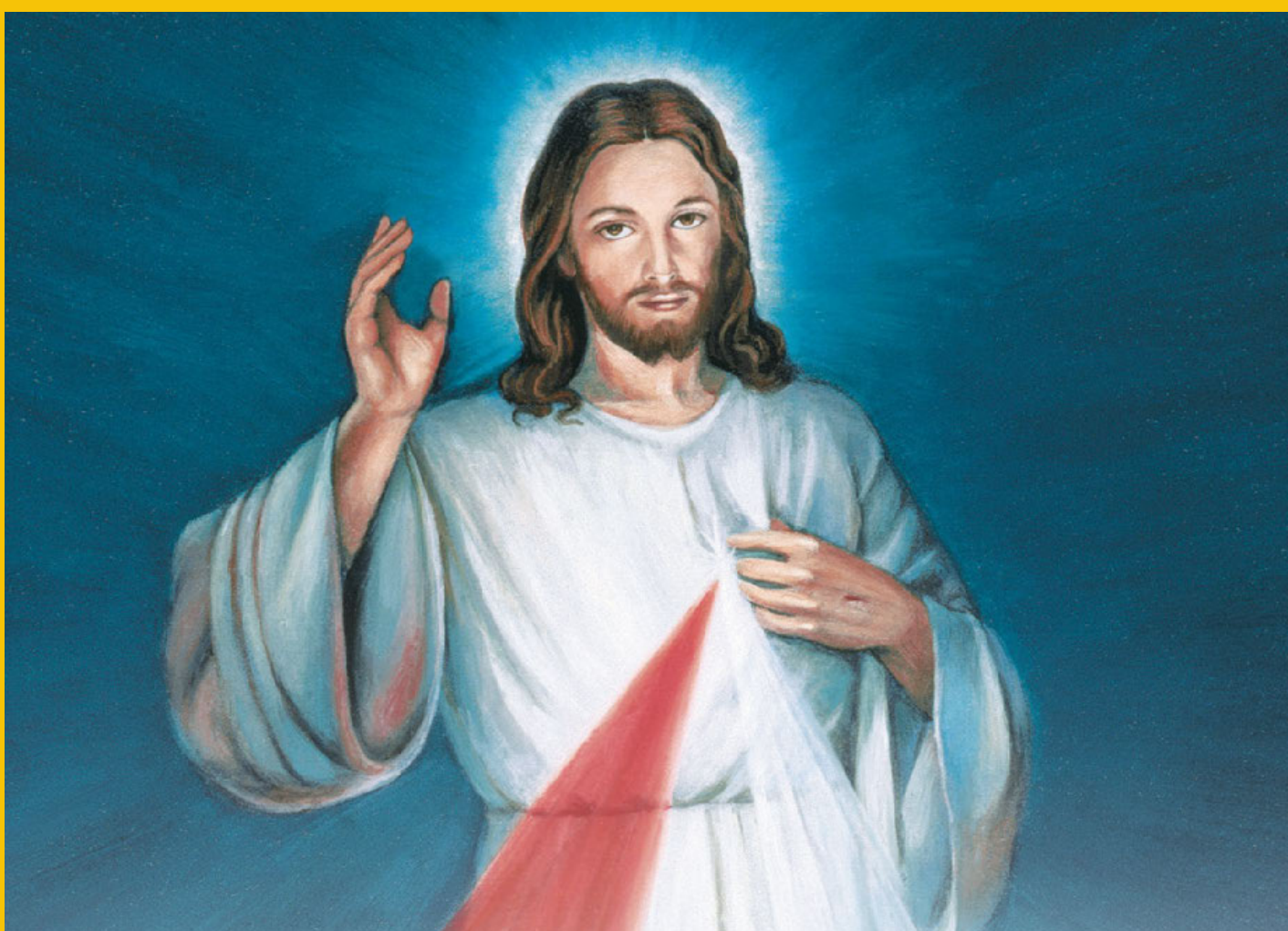

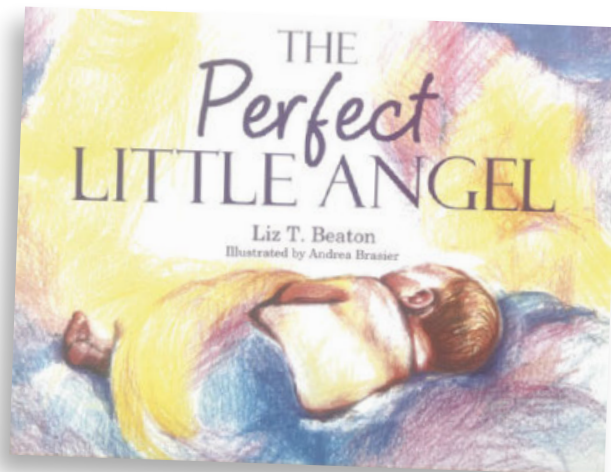

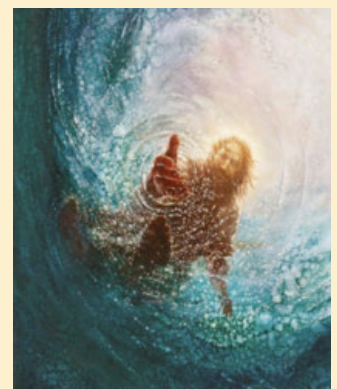
GRACE & RECOVERY RETREAT

SUMMER SCHOOL OF THEOLOGY, JUNE 17-21

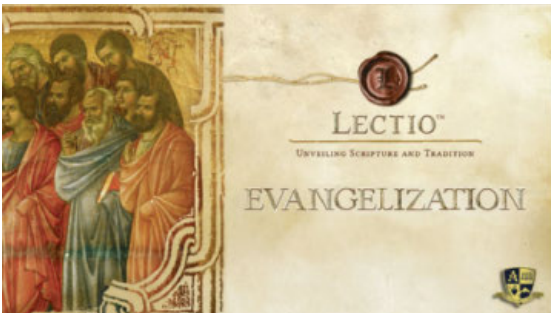
Join us for the **16th Annual Summer School of Theology** held from **June 17-21** at the **Marywood Retreat & Conference Center in St. Johns**.

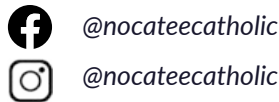
