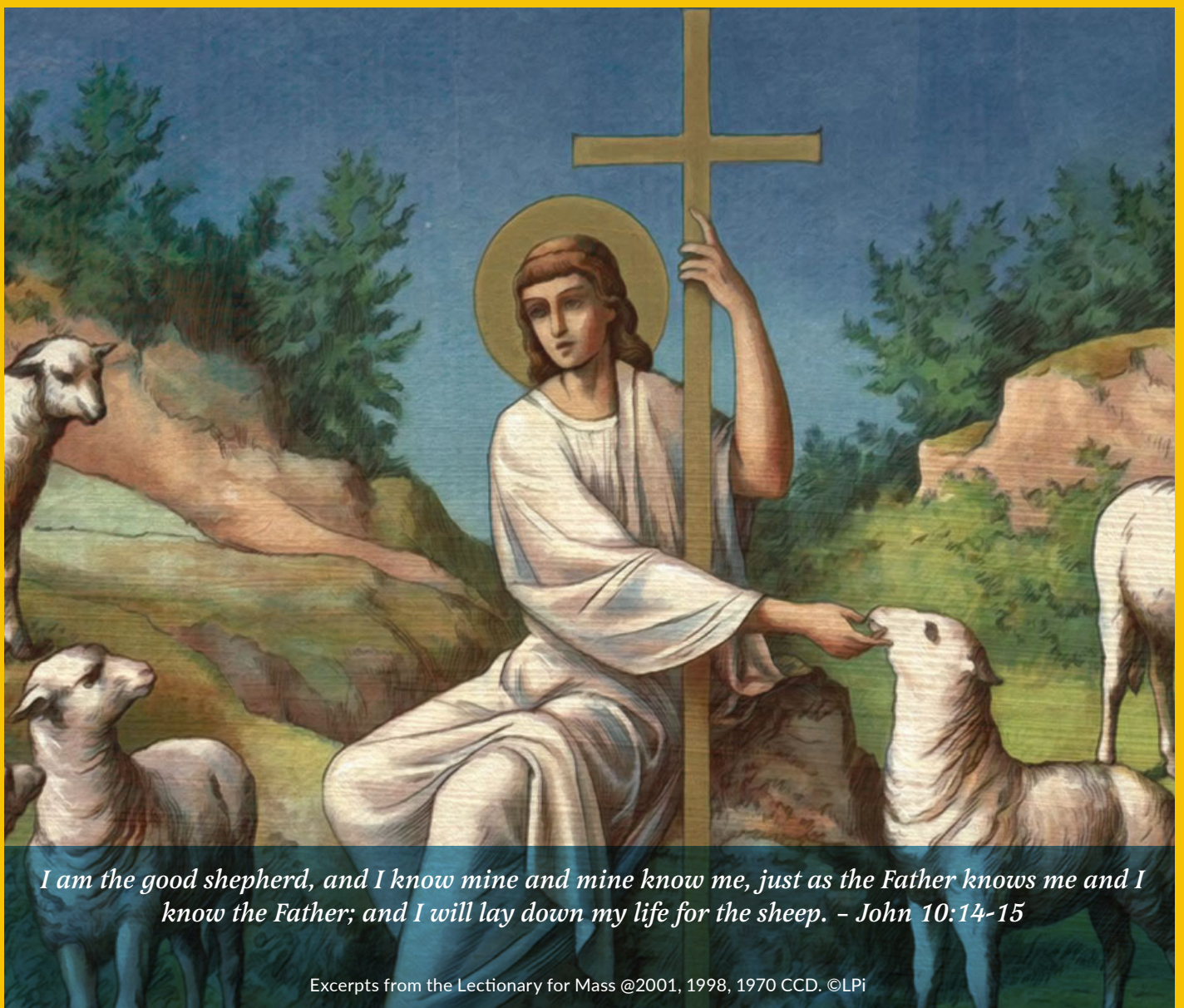

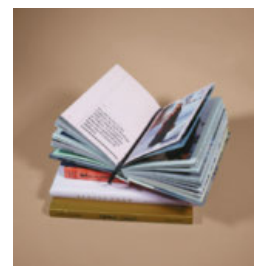
LITERACY EVENT - SUNDAY, MAY 12TH

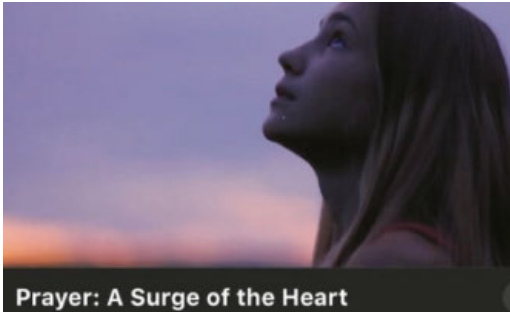
