Grief and the Holidays

Surviving the Holidays while experiencing deep grief can feel like an ominous task. Under the best of circumstances, the Christmas Season presents many challenges. The expectations of a Hallmark Christmas with cozy fires, Christmas Caroling and ongoing joy may not always come to fruition. Although a time of magic and wonder...our routines are disrupted, fatigue may be present, and children may get sick, relegating them to the couch for Christmas Day.... And yet, the Christmas Season is a time of prayer, hope and peace and taking time to gather with family and friends.

For those who have lost a loved one...the pain of their absence may be unbearable...while the entire world is singing, "JOY TO THE WORLD" The Christmas Season may bring the feeling of dread and deep sadness. It may be that the anticipation of Christmas Day is harder than the actual day, and it always comes. How do we survive this season while we are absorbed in the pain of grief?

We have learned some ways of coping from many who have shared their stories in our bereavement groups:



- 1. Make a plan for Christmas Day.
- 2. Be with others that understand your pain
- 3. If you are flooded with emotion at Christmas time, avoid Christmas songs that may overwhelm you...or listen to them if they bring you comfort.
- 4. Take care of yourself if possible...your whole body grieves.
- 5. Make a list of the rituals you want to keep and the plans you want to change.
- 6. Some people plan a vacation away from the sights and sounds of Christmas.

At St. John Paul II, we come together to share your joy and your grief. It may be a time to refocus on the meaning of Christmas while grieving. Our scriptures are filled with hope at the coming of new life through Jesus whose life gave us a new meaning of life and death. We can wrap our deep pain and grief in a gift, like the Magi, to the birth of our hope in new life. We pray to find the meaning of our loss by entering the mystery of God's love and the reality of healing through our community...God's love shows up when least expected. Our arms and hearts are always open.

The Lord rebuilds Jerusalem, and gathers the dispersed of Israel, healing the brokenhearted, and binding up their wounds. ??






GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

The Blessed Virgin teaches us the secret to being blessed, happy, and full of joy. When Elizabeth, her cousin, greets her, she calls Mary "blessed" for two reasons, her motherhood of Jesus, and Our Lady's belief that "there would be a fulfillment of what was spoken to her by the Lord" (Luke 1:45).

Mary is "blessed" entirely because of her relationship to the Incarnation of God in Jesus, and for no other. This of course makes perfect sense, because as the Lord, as God-in-the-flesh, her son is the source of all blessedness, life, and joy. Mary is blessed because of her contact with Jesus, and by her faith in him.

So, it is with us, too. We become blessed by our "motherly" contact with Christ in our souls through baptism. He lives in us and grows to maturity within us. We bear him to the world. This requires


