#### A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

Today, we begin the season of Lent; we enter into this season as pilgrims ready to journey for 40 days with a heart prepared for repentance, and we look forward to experiencing the joy of Jesus' resurrection come Easter Sunday.

Last Tuesday, I concelebrated the funeral mass for Father William Mooney, the long-time pastor of Corpus Christi Parish in St. Augustine, FL. He was the pastor of that parish for 40 years. Before the final commendation, the Knights of Columbus did their traditional final roll call for the deceased. As the name of Faithful Friar Father William Mooney was called for the first and second time, there was silence, and on the third time, one of the knights announced to the congregation that he was absent and in the presence of the Lord. The moment touched everyone inside the church, and tears filled every mourner's eyes. What a profound experience for me. A faithful and loving priest like Father Mooney has a special place in the heart of Jesus.

Wednesday morning, 6/26, was a somber day for the faithful of the beaches as they woke up to the sad news of the passing of the beloved Father Bill Kelly, also known as "the priest of the beaches." He was indeed a priest molded after the heart of Jesus; for years, he lived a life of service and compassion to the fold God entrusted to him; days leading to his passing, he visited sick people, celebrated baptisms, and had funerals in his retirement days. Eternal Rest grant unto Fr. Kelly, O Lord, and let your perpetual light shine upon him; may he rest in peace. Amen.


#### MUSIC MINISTRY






