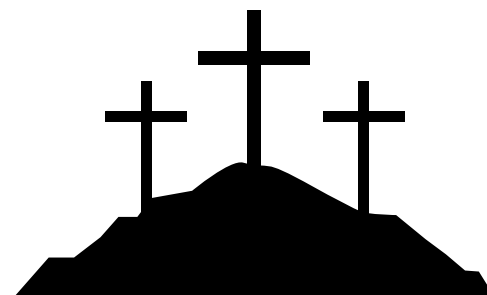

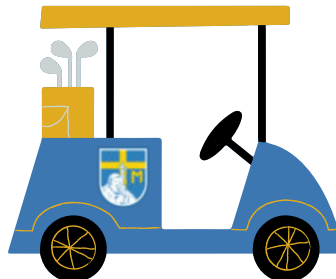

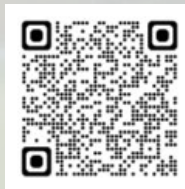
KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS

ALTAR SERVERS

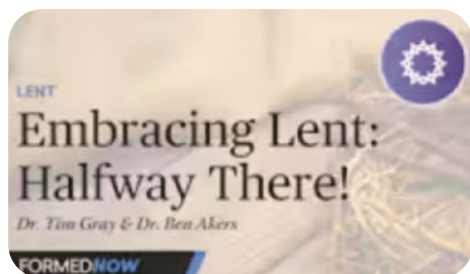
