A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

A few days ago, I went to our office manager and asked her if we could switch roles even for a day. She responded, "That's why you are always in our prayers; I can't imagine how priests, in general, do the things they do." That day was one of those days that I was so thankful I am a Catholic Priest. My day went on as usual. I started around five for my morning routines, Divine Office, prayers, confessions, and Mass. As soon as I got to the office, I had one appointment after another. I was able to console a lady whose husband is in hospice right now; I was able to meet a mother who's very worried about her children; I was able to set up a significant repair at the rectory, answered emails for sacramental preparations, called the Diocese for some administrative concerns, counseled a parishioner for some personal issues, had quick talks with staff members for upcoming Holy Week concerns - this was the first half of the day, and I was so excited to see what the other half of the day would bring me. Days like those make my heart big, and I am so thankful for the vocation God has given me.

As we enter Holy Week, I realize my busy life is nothing compared to Jesus' life when he was with us. People were following him constantly, and he had no time to rest. The Paschal Mystery (Jesus' passion, death, resurrection, and ascension) reminds us that our suffering here on earth will be rewarded with the joyous reward of the resurrection when the time comes.

I encourage you to participate in all our Holy Week Liturgical Celebrations. Our active participation will strengthen our faith and connect all our sufferings to Jesus, who suffered first and died for our salvation. I am looking forward to seeing all of you this Holy Week.

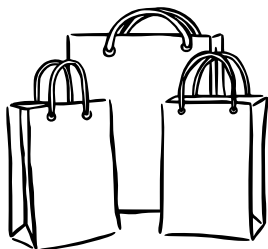

ADORATION MINISTRY

Lent is a wonderful time to practice adoration, spending time in silence with our Lord.

Adoration is the worship of the Eucharist outside of the Mass. The Eucharistic Host is displayed in a monstrance on the altar and parishioners can pray in the presence of Christ.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church tells us that, ***'Adoration is the first attitude of man acknowledging that he is a creature before his Creator. It exalts the greatness of the Lord who made us and the almighty power of the Savior who sets us free from evil. Adoration is homage of the spirit to the "King of Glory," "respectful silence in the presence of the "ever greater" God. Adoration of the thrice holy and sovereign God of love blends with humility and gives assurance to our supplications.'*** (CCC 2628)

We can show our adoration to God in many ways. Adoration, is a special time to spend in silence in the presence of Christ in the Eucharist

Eucharistic Adoration takes place **every Wednesday from 9:00 am – 4:00 pm**, followed by evening prayer and benediction. You can stop at your convenience or sign up to participate during a specific time.

Twenty-four-hour Adoration occurs on the First Friday and First Saturday of each month following daily Mass.
