A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

I just celebrated my 13th Chrism Mass here in our Diocese. The Bishop and his priests, both retired and active, concelebrate this annual celebration at the Cathedral of St. Augustine. The Bishop consecrates the Sacred Chrism at this Mass and blesses the other oils. In this Mass, one can genuinely feel the close bond of the Bishop with his priests, who are his co-pastors in taking care of the flock of Jesus—the Church.

Every year at the Chrism Mass, I always look forward to the renewal of our Priestly Promises wherein the Bishop asks us to renew our resolve to be more united with Jesus, to conform our will to him, to deny ourselves, to be faithful stewards and to discharge faithfully our sacred office of teaching the flock - we all say, I am. As we were renewing our priestly vows - I WAS THINKING ABOUT YOU. After almost a year with you here at JP2, I need to be more united with Jesus in prayer, adoration, and service to you. I need to constantly remind myself that I am living a life of "in persona Christi," that it is 24/7, no day off, no time out. I am reminded to deny myself and take up his cross daily as I serve you as your Pastor. I am reminded of my duty to teach you through my preaching and, moreso, in the holiness of my life. What a tall order, but as I said to the Bishop, I am; it means I will try my best to live up to it. This Easter, it's not only me, your Pastor, who is being challenged to renew; you are also challenged to renew your Baptismal Promises. Together, we will make our renewal alive in our lives and in the service that we will extend to our brothers and sisters.

At Easter, I also look forward to welcoming our brothers and sisters in the OCIA program to the fullness of our Catholic faith. It's always an emotional moment for me, remembering the first time I met each of them to the time I embraced them to welcome them to the Church that Christ established here on earth.

Recently, a good friend and a trusted adviser forwarded to me an article written by Cardinal Dolan, an opinion at Wall Street Journal dated 3/28/2024 titled, "Why pews are packed on Easter Sunday." The good Cardinal mentioned the reality of Christers, as some of us may refer to them, but he also mentioned a fact that we all need to think about and ponder in our hearts; he says, allow me to quote him, "Faith is deeply personal, but it isn't private. By its nature, faith is communal. A congregation is a spiritual family. Many use that word "family" loosely to mean any group of like-minded friends, from which any member can part ways for any reason. A biological family doesn't work like that—it's unchosen, it's permanent, and loyalty to it doesn't wane with preference or mood. Members of a spiritual family likewise bear an obligation to remain a part of it." Here at JP2, we strive to become part of our parish family, a church of disciples making disciples. As we actively participate in our liturgical celebrations, we make it a point to participate in our ministries, particularly our outreach to the poor, materially and spiritually, and those in need in our community.

To conclude this, allow me to quote the good Cardinal one more time: he says, "They tell us they want to believe but not belong; that they want faith but not religion; that they prefer spirituality, whatever that might mean, to communal worship. They seem to want God as a Father but to remain an only child; Jesus as the Good Shepherd if they're the only lamb in the flock. They want a God by themselves, Christ without his Church. Let me challenge you: how can we embrace and welcome people in our community and make them feel they truly belong? How can we proclaim the Kingdom that Christ established here on earth to them? How can we inspire them to become disciples as we all strive to?

From all of us here at St. John Paul II, serving you, Happy Easter.






