OUR LADY OF FATIMA SHRINE MINISTRY




The Heralds of the Gospel, founded by Monsignor João Scognamiglio Clá Dias, is a Catholic International Association of Christ's Faithful of Pontifical Right. The goal of the ministry is to adequately respond to the insistent call of St. John Paul II by cooperating with bishops and priests in the effort for a new evangelization of their parishes. This work not only seeks to benefit individuals but also entire families. Essentially it involves forming groups of 12-15 families in which a shrine of Our Lady of Fatima travels from home to home on pilgrimage. Families receive the shrine in their homes for two days each month, on a date agreed upon by the coordinator. On the designated day, each family invites friends, relatives, and neighbors to recite the rosary and perform an act of consecration to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Currently, our church SJP II has five Shrines (72 families involve) that are praying the Rosary as a family every month.






