PATRIOTIC ROSARY MINISTRY

In 2024, the Patriotic Rosary began and continues to be prayed at the monthly meetings of the Knights of Columbus 4th Degree Assembly meetings. In 2025, with the concurrence of SJPII leadership, the Knights of Columbus formed the Patriotic Rosary Ministry and coordinates the praying of the Patriotic Rosary with our Parish members four times per year as follows: January: to commemorate the Solemnity of the Blessed Mother; May: to commemorate Memorial Day; July: to commemorate Independence Day; September: to commemorate Patriots Day and Veterans Day.

The Patriotic Rosary follows the traditional structure of the Catholic Rosary (Joyful, Sorrowful, Glorious, and Luminous Mysteries), but includes special prayers and intentions interspersed throughout: Each "Hail Mary" is offered for one of the 50 U.S. states—one state per bead. This fosters a sense of unity and a call to pray for all citizens regardless of political or religious affiliation; Each decade is introduced with a quote from a Founding Father or American leader. These include: Prayers for the President, Congress, and Supreme Court; Prayers for priests, religious leaders, and the conversion of the nation. The Our Father is offered for specific branches of government.




