


GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

What We Store in the Barn

I once knew a godly woman who had truly tasted the bitterness of this earthly life. This woman knew pain. She knew sacrifice. She knew hard labor and loss, including the death of a cherished child. She worked each day at a low-paying job, waiting patiently for her 65th birthday, when she could retire and devote herself full-time to her grandchildren. She crossed off the dwindling days on her calendar like a first grader waiting for Christmas.

Ninety-eight days before she was set to retire, she died suddenly. Her name was erased from the schedule at work and penciled over with that of her replacement hire.

All things are vanity.

I think we all know someone like this, don't we? If the details aren't exactly the same, the outline of the story is: someone labors "with wisdom and knowledge and skill," in the words of Ecclesiastes. And what profit comes to him? Sorrow and grief all his days. The proverbial barn filled with harvest and left to rot.

But I'll let you in on a secret: this isn't a sad story. I've only told you part of it.

This woman heard, daily, the voice of God, and against it she never hardened her heart, whatever news it brought her. This woman loved as hard as she worked. Every action was a form of evangelization. To talk to her was to feel the embrace of Christ.

As much as she waited for that retirement that never came, it was never the harvest in her barn.

This is what it means to be a true steward: to seek what is above.

Interested in ways to get more active in the parish? Our ministries offer many things including faith & fellowship as well as volunteer opportunities, and more! This week, we are featuring our

BIBLE STUDY

Pope Gregory the Great said, "The scripture is like a river broad and deep, shallow enough here for the lamb to go wading and deep enough there for the elephant to swim."

The Holy Scriptures guide us as Catholics to the knowledge of truth – that is of Jesus Christ. Through the Bible Study Ministry, we trace God's plan of redemption from creation to resurrection. The scriptures are where we deepen our relationship with God and learn to fall in love with him "with all our heart, soul and mind." The whole of Sacred Scripture was, for Saint Augustine, a call to love God and neighbor.

The mission of the Bible Study Ministry is that the sacred scriptures be taught "to "lead believers to the full truth and make the Word of Christ dwell in them in all its richness."

COMMENTS FROM CURRENT BIBLE STUDY MEMBERS

"This is my first bible study. It taught me how to go about studying the Bible and how the Catechism ties in with the Bible. It gave me an examination of my own faith."

"I have grown in my knowledge of the Bible and in my faith. I have tried to institute from the study what God wants me to do more fully in my daily life."

"Studying the word of God gives me a framework to lead a better life in Christ. Meeting my fellow parishioners is very special to me as a recent widow and needing people of faith in my life."

Another important aspect of the Bible Study Ministry is to build community. We meet in small groups of 8-12 and gather for potluck meals a couple of times each session.

"The study strengthened my understanding in the Gospels and readings used at Mass. My faith in the Old and New Testaments was enhanced! It brought the history of the Catholic Church more alive to me."

"The study was informative and builds community at our church. The opportunity to be fed the Word of God in community builds our unity as members of the Body of Christ."

"There has been a deepening of faith and friendship. I'm gaining the ability to articulate my faith being around others who are so adept."

"Meeting in small groups has allowed me to make new friends and connect with others in the parish." "Very inspiring, enlightening and educational. Creates bonding of new friendships. I eagerly anticipate each week's study."

Over the past three years, Tammy Davis has led the Bible Study Ministry, which features a combination of video, lecture, and small group activities. This fall marks the tenth year of the SJPII Bible Study Ministry. The upcoming session will focus on the Gospel of Luke, corresponding to Year C in the Catholic Church calendar.

The Gospel of Luke demonstrates how Jesus fulfills Old Testament prophecies. *Luke: The Story of Salvation Fulfilled*from Ascension Publishing highlights God's faithfulness through history and shows how these promises
remain relevant today.

Luke: the Story of Salvation Fulfilled at SJPII begins **Thursday**, **September 11th**, **from 9:45 am to 11:45am**, **and continues every Thursday until October 30th**.
