Walking with PURPOSE
Enabling women to know Christ through Scripture



In September, we will begin our fourth year of the Walking with Purpose Bible Study at St. John Paul II. Walking with Purpose was founded in 2008 as a nonprofit Catholic women's ministry, and they provide a number of bible studies for women as well as for teens and tweens. Walking with Purpose Bible studies help women grow closer to Christ as they lean on truths found in Scripture.

At St. John Paul II, the Walking with Purpose bible study meets once a week, on Tuesday mornings, September through April or May, depending on the length of the Bible Study we are covering. We break into small groups for our study and discussion, and for 3-4 sessions a year, we watch a "Coffee Connect" video, followed by coffee, breakfast and discussion.

Last year over 80 ladies participated in our ministry, and we hope to see more new faces this year! Each year, the ladies are assigned randomly to their small groups. In this way, we get the opportunity to connect with other ladies of the parish and no one joining us for the first time feels like an outsider. It is amazing the friendships and sense of community that form during each year as we spend time together with other women of faith!

This year we will be following the Walking with Purpose study call "Touching the Divine." This study will focus on the many qualities of Jesus revealed through the gospel of John. More information and a link to sign up will be available at NocateeCatholic.com/WWP.

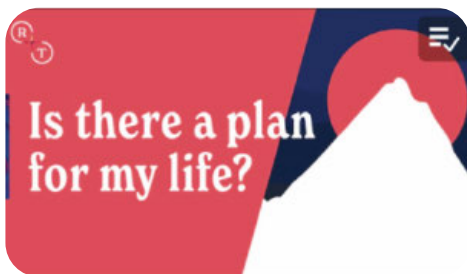

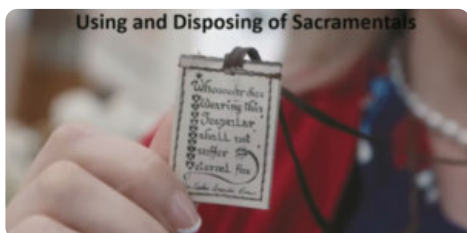

CATECHIST/SMALL GROUP LEADERS NEEDED!

Are you looking to get involved at SJPII and love working with our youth? If so, we would love to invite you to prayerfully consider ministering as a catechist or small group leader this year!

What does a K-6 catechist do at SJPII?

A catechist helps lead small groups sessions of children in grades K-6 at our Family Lesson Meetings that take place either on a Thursday evening or Sunday afternoon about twice a month.

What about confirmation small group leaders?

Small group leaders work with teens in our confirmation programs. Confirmation Year 1 meets on Wednesday nights in either our Blaze or Fraternus groups. Confirmation Year 2 meets on Sunday evenings.

What are the requirements?

Small group leaders and K-6 catechists should be at least 18 years old and complete a Safe Environment training (which includes attending a Protecting God's Children workshop and fingerprinting).

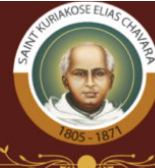


