#### **SPOTLIGHT MINISTRY**

Interested in ways to get more active in the parish? Our ministries offer many things including faith & fellowship as well as volunteer opportunities, and more! This week, we are featuring



In September, we will begin our fourth year of the Walking with Purpose Bible Study at St. John Paul II. Walking with Purpose was founded in 2008 as a nonprofit Catholic women's ministry, and they provide a number of bible studies for women as well as for teens and tweens. Walking with Purpose Bible studies help women grow closer to Christ as they lean on truths found in Scripture.

At St. John Paul II, the Walking with Purpose bible study meets once a week, on Tuesday mornings, September through April or May, depending on the length of the Bible Study we are covering. We break into small groups for our study and discussion, and for 3-4 sessions a year, we watch a "Coffee Connect" video, followed by coffee, breakfast and discussion.

Last year over 80 ladies participated in our ministry, and we hope to see more new faces this year!

Each year, the ladies are assigned randomly to their small groups. In this way, we get the opportunity to connect with other ladies of the parish and no one joining us for the first time feels like an outsider. It is amazing the friendships and sense of community that form during each year as we spend time together with other women of faith!

This year we will be following the Walking with Purpose study call "Touching the Divine." This study will focus on the many qualities of Jesus revealed through the gospel of John. More information and a link to sign up will be available at NocateeCatholic.com/WWP.

- Attend any of our meetings on the **1st and 3rd Thursday of each month, from 2:00 to 3:30 pm**, at the back of the church. Yarn, hooks/needles, and patterns (if needed) are available for knitters and crocheters. Also, teachers are usually available for those who would like to learn to crochet.
- Make shawls and lap blankets at home, whether you can or can't attend meetings (again supplies can be provided)
- Donate yarn, needles/hooks or other supplies and/or 1 ½ yards of fleece (we're especially low of this)


