The Prayer Shawl Ministry is a gathering of community members who have an interest in or a talent for knitting, crocheting, sewing or no-sew techniques to create the shawls and lap blankets. We invite you to join us in wrapping others in God's love and comfort.

There are several ways that you can participate in this ministry:

- Attend any of our meetings on the 1st and 3rd Thursday of each month, from 2:00 to 3:30 pm, at the back of the church. Yarn, hooks/needles, and patterns (if needed) are available for knitters and crocheters. Also, teachers are usually available for those who would like to learn to crochet.
• Make shawls and lap blankets at home, whether you can or can't attend meetings (again supplies can be provided)
• Donate yarn, needles/hooks or other supplies and/or 1 1/2 yards of fleece (we're especially low of this)

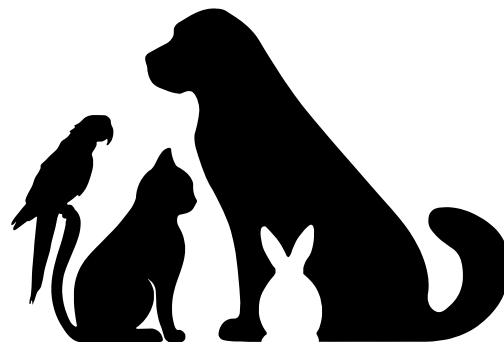

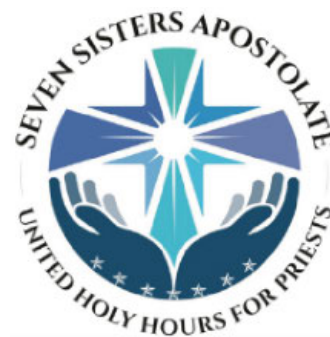
