## A FEW WORDS FROM FR. ROBERT

### We Walk by Faith

Last week our parish and our school suffered the death of one of our 5th Graders. London Williams could walk into a room and light it up with a smile. She loved our school so much that one of her aunts told us that it was hard to get her out of her uniform into her play clothes when she got home. She was a big fan of Coach Black and I'm told knew how to handle a basketball. Somehow beautiful London came home last week, tried to take a bath and fell into the bathtub where she drowned. While it seemed for a few moments that she might pull through, her condition quickly deteriorated and she died on Sunday morning around 11:00 a.m. The experience of death is always trying and perhaps one of the biggest obstacles to faith, but it is even more difficult when someone so young and full of life dies unexpectedly. **London's untimely death reminds us that every moment that we are given in this life is precious. We need to appreciate that and use the time we are allotted to leave the world a better place.** We need to remember that Jesus teaches us that this life is not our home. Heaven is our home. One of our little 5th graders told her Mom that she was sad that London died, but she was not afraid because heaven is better and that's where London is. At the end of our memorial service for London one of her aunts got up and spoke on behalf of the family. She ended by saying that though they would deeply miss London her family walks by faith. May we all do the same.



### Annual Catholic Appeal

It is always so important to remember that we are part of a bigger church and because of this we have a shared responsibility to support all of the good works of the Diocese of Savannah. Every year we are given a goal based on around 10% of our annual offertory collection. This year our goal for the Annual Catholic Appeal was \$140,258.00 and to date we have collected \$141,001.02. Thank you so very much! Rest assured my only concern regarding the appeal is that our percentage of participation in the appeal remains low - around 27%. Next year I hope that we can figure out a way to meet our goal with a greater level of participation. **Heartfelt thanks to everyone who supported the work of the universal Church this year.**

### Inclement Weather

Up North we used to love snow days. Growing up, no one loved a snow day more than my father. He was an elementary school principal and he used to love it when the superintendent called at 5:00 a.m. to tell him that school would be closed. When we heard the phone ring that early we all used to roll over and keep sleeping. There was no virtual learning back then. A snow day was a snow day. From now on if St. Anne-Pacelli is closed because of inclement weather, the Parish Office will also be closed and the parish staff will regularly check messages from home and work virtually. Thanks for your understanding.

### The Finance Council Meeting

The Parish Finance Council met last Thursday to review last year's financial reports. Both the school and the parish finished in the black. Our increased enrollment and the Covid Offertory Appeal contributed to our financial well-being last year. Rest assured that every aspect of our parish and school finances are reviewed by the Finance Council. Later in the fall we will present a financial report to the whole parish.


**VIRTUAL BAPTISM CLASS**






