## A FEW WORDS FROM FR. ROBERT

### Extraordinary Provincial Chapter

Every four years the friars gather in a Provincial Chapter or meeting to pray and discern God's call in our life and do our best to follow it. This year there will be two chapters which we will be called to attend, one next week and one in the spring and summer of next year. While we are away, the weekday Masses will be canceled here at St. Anne. I encourage you to attend the 12:10 p.m. Masses at Holy Family Church. Should there be an emergency, our staff will do its best to find a local priest to celebrate any funerals which should arise and anoint those who are sick. Please request the Anointing of the Sick as soon as someone becomes ill or is hospitalized.

### Anointing of the Sick

Even though I have written about this several times, sometimes a little review is worthwhile.

There is still a lot of confusion about this Sacrament of the Sick. Before the Second Vatican Council 50 years ago the sacrament was often called Extreme Unction or Last Rites. Last Rites was usually administered as close to a person's death as possible. When a sick person saw a priest come in they often thought to themselves, "Oh, I must be really sick." We have to do all we can to help people remember that this is no longer how we understand the Sacrament of the Sick.

### Here are some key things to remember about the Sacrament of the Sick:

- The Sacrament of the Sick is not only intended for those who are close to death, but, even more so for those who are just ill or who might be facing a test or surgery in a hospital. Sometimes it is administered to people who are chronically ill, have a lot of health issues or who are facing serious challenges in their life.
- The friars are happy to anoint anyone who asks to receive the sacrament. Many people stop the friars after Mass and ask to be anointed and we are happy to do so. **If you are going to the hospital or going for tests, please stop by after Mass and ask to be anointed before you go.**
- When a person receives the Sacrament of the Sick they receive a special grace to carry the burden of their illness. They are united more closely to the Passion of Christ, and their sins are forgiven. Here are the words that the priest prays when he anoints someone:  

"Through this holy anointing may the Lord in His love and mercy help you. With the grace of the Holy Spirit may the Lord who frees you from all of your sins save you and raise you up."
- It is much better for a person to be aware that they are receiving the sacrament because it can be of great comfort to them to know that their sins are forgiven and that God is very close to them. When a person is still aware they can also receive Holy Communion when the priest arrives. **It is not good to wait until someone is in Hospice or near death to call for the priest. The Sacrament should be celebrated as soon as possible whenever a person becomes seriously ill.**
- I have found that sometimes children do not know about the importance of the Sacrament of the Sick. If you want to receive the sacrament, please let them know or put a note on your refrigerator saying, "If I get ill please call the parish." Knowing what you want will be a big comfort to your children.
- While we can and do pray for the repose of the soul of someone who has died, a priest cannot celebrate the Sacrament of the Sick for someone who has already passed away.

God's love and mercy always shines through the challenges or illnesses that come our way. The Sacrament of the Sick is one way that God chooses to be particularly close to those who are sick and suffering. Let us all do whatever we can to help people understand the beauty of this sacrament and encourage them to celebrate it as often as they need to.

What a blessing to have so many volunteers to be a part of our young people's lives. 
## PRO-LIFE NEWS




