



Reflection on Sunday's Readings





Jesus continued to amaze His listeners with His teachings. This past Sunday, Luke presented his version of the beatitudes, in which Jesus blesses those who are poor, marginalized, or rejected. His statement was contrary to the common notion at that time that poverty and hardship are curses and riches and abundance are the measures of being blessed.

This Sunday, Jesus says, love your enemies. Of course, this is challenging to do and it is contrary to the conventional belief at that time: a tooth for a tooth, an eye for an eye. When people heard Jesus teaching them to love their enemies, they might have expected Jesus to ask them to be friendly with the Romans, whom they considered their adversary. The Romans imposed unjust laws, including paying excessive taxes to their government.

In a more ordinary context, Jesus' message of loving our enemies would mean enemies within families and communities. "Enemies" may mean people we dislike or are unpleasant to our sight. They may be people we do not get along with even though how much we try. Jesus said, love them and be merciful to them.

Showing love and mercy to our enemies means we have to do good to them, pray for them, and bless them. Jesus enlivens the Old Testament teachings of loving our enemies, such as the one written in the book of Proverbs that says, "If your enemy is hungry, give him food to eat; if he is thirsty, give him water to drink. In doing this, you will heap burning coals on his head, and the Lord will reward you." (Prov 25:21-22)

Jesus himself demonstrates to us the love for enemies. He asks forgiveness for the Roman soldiers who are crucifying Him. He said, "Father, forgive them for they know not what they do." (Luke 23-24)

In his command to love our enemies, Jesus also wanted to show mercy to the sinners and the outcast by engaging with them. Unlike the belief of the Pharisees to separate themselves from enemies and sinners that would render a person unclean, Jesus spent time with those neglected by society. He touched the lepers, kept in contact with those afflicted with unclean spirits, and dined with tax collectors. By being merciful and compassionate, He brought them back to God and transformed their lives.

As we could tell, the path to God is not always an easy road to follow, and it entails a lot of sacrifice and love on our part. However, in the long run, following what Jesus asks us to do brings much joy and fulfillment in our temporal and spiritual lives. Jesus's teachings bring us to the Kingdom, where we experience God's eternal reward.
