Reflection on Sunday's Readings

Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord

Kings and Cloaks

We hear in today's procession Gospel of Jesus' glorious and exuberant entrance into Jerusalem. The Jews knew that the Messiah would go to Jerusalem, the center of Jewish life, to establish and claim His reign and free them from Roman occupation and oppression. As He enters the city, it appears that a multitude of people begin to praise God with shouts of joy proclaiming Jesus as their king. But their shouting isn't enough to truly express their emotions, so we're told that they begin to lay down their cloaks along Jesus' path.

In Jesus' days, cloaks were a very important item. They provided shelter and protection from the elements and provided warmth during the night. Many parts of Scripture speak of the important roles that cloaks served in biblical times. When the people laid them down on the road, they knew that they would be trampled upon, soiled, and possibly ruined, but this didn't stop them from doing it despite its importance and value.

While their outer voices were shouting praises recognizing Jesus as their king, their inner voices reminded them that their words alone lacked sufficient meaning unless they were backed up and supported by some outward act. That act had to show that they had "skin in the game". It was like putting money on the table to show one's sincerity and level of commitment to an agreement. By placing their cloaks on the road before Jesus, they gave Him honor and demonstrated that they truly believed in Him. It outwardly showed that they welcomed Him as their king, and it was the right thing to do to show that they really meant it. It was the best act they could perform to back up their voices to prove their support.

As we wave our palm branches at Mass today to welcome Jesus as our King with shouts of praise, we too, must decide what we're willing to do to show that He truly is our King? We all have "cloaks" that we tightly cling to and tend to value greater than Jesus, things that we don't want to let go of. Everything we have isn't really ours, they are gifts from God. What are we willing to do to prove that Jesus indeed is the King of our hearts?

May Jesus' entrance into Jerusalem lead you to a blessed and faith-filled Holy Week.

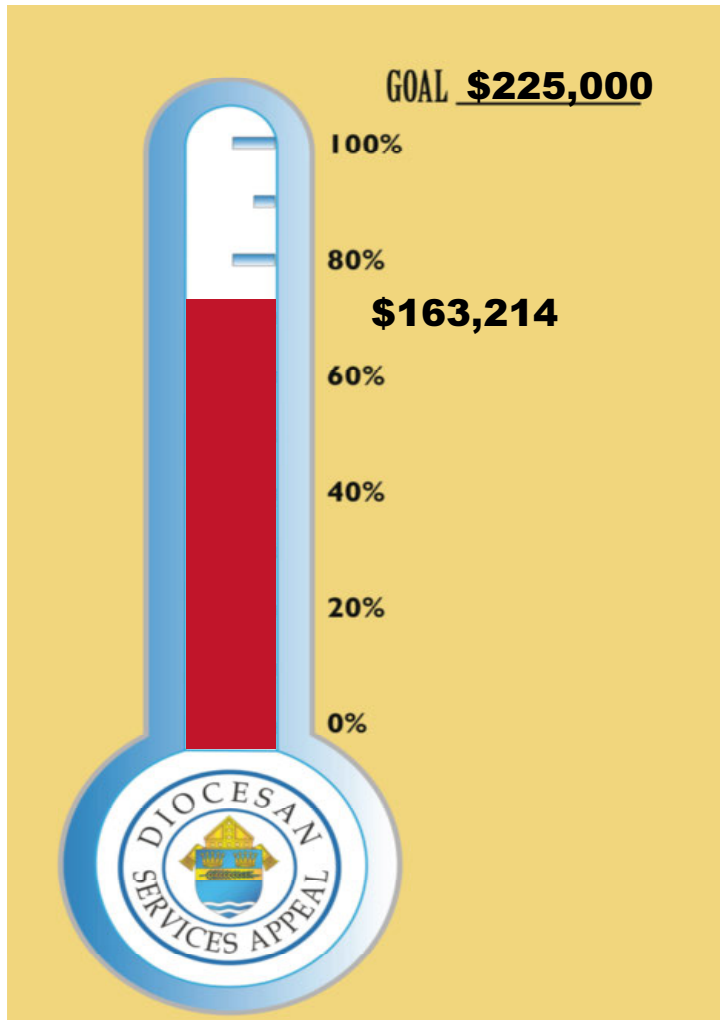

DIVINE MERCY DEVOTIONS

Through St. Faustina, the Merciful Savior has given the world new channels for the outpouring of His grace through:

- ✠ the Image of The Divine Mercy,
- ✠ the Feast of Mercy (Divine Mercy Sunday),
- ✠ the Chaplet of Divine Mercy,
- ✠ the Novena to The Divine Mercy,
- ✠ Prayer at 3:00 in the afternoon, the Hour of Great Mercy.

The Image of The Divine Mercy

In 1931, our Lord appeared to Saint Faustina in a vision. She saw Jesus clothed in a white garment with His right hand raised in blessing. His left hand was touching His garment in the area of the Heart, from where two large rays came forth, one red and the other pale. She gazed intently at the Lord in silence, her soul filled with awe, but also with great joy. Jesus said to her: *Paint an image according to the pattern you see, with the signature: Jesus, I trust in You. I promise that the soul that will venerate this image will not perish. I also promise victory over [its] enemies already here on earth, especially at the hour of death. I Myself will defend it as My own glory (Diary, 47, 48). I am offering people a vessel with which they are to keep coming for graces to the fountain of mercy. That vessel is this image with the signature: Jesus, I trust in You (327). I desire that this image be venerated, first in your chapel, and [then] throughout the world (47).*

St. Faustina asked the Lord about the meaning of the rays in the image.

The two rays denote Blood and Water. The pale ray stands for the Water which makes souls righteous. The red ray stands for the Blood which is the life of souls. These two rays issued forth from the depths of My tender mercy when My agonized Heart was opened by a lance on the Cross. Happy is the one who will dwell in their shelter, for the just hand of God shall not lay hold of him (299). By means of this image I shall grant many graces to souls. It is to be a reminder of the demands of My mercy, because even the strongest faith is of no avail without works (742). These words indicate that the Image represents the graces of Divine Mercy poured out upon the world,

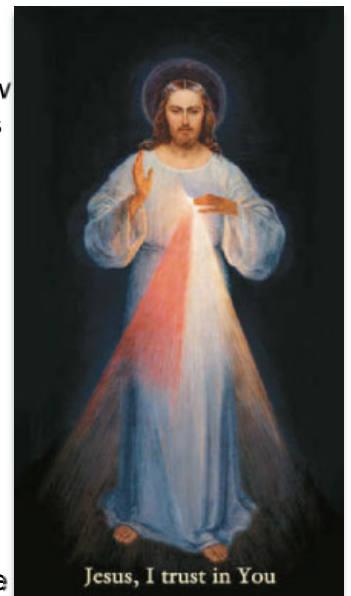
especially through Baptism and the Eucharist.

When St. Faustina first saw the original image that was being painted under her direction, she wept in disappointment to Jesus:

“Who will paint You as beautiful as You are?” (313). In answer, she heard these words:

“Not in the beauty of the color, nor of the brush lies the greatness of this image, but in My grace” (313).

The Divine Mercy Novena of Chaplets*

A novena is nine days of prayer in preparation of a celebration of a feast day. The Chaplet can be said anytime, but the Lord specifically asked that it be recited as a novena. He promised, "By this Novena [of Chaplets], I will grant every possible grace to souls" (796). These intentions are customarily used together with the Novena of Chaplets
***Begins on Good Friday**

Intentions

For each day of this Novena, our Lord gave St. Faustina a special prayer intention:

- Day 1: All mankind, especially sinners;
- Day 2: The souls of priests and religious;
- Day 3: All devout and faithful souls;
- Day 4: Those who do not believe in God and those who do not yet know Jesus;
- Day 5: The souls who have separated themselves from the Church;
- Day 6: The meek and humble souls and the souls of little children;
- Day 7: The souls who especially venerate and glorify His mercy;
- Day 8: The souls detained in purgatory;
- Day 9: The souls who have become lukewarm.



“I desire that during these nine days you bring souls to the fountain of My mercy, that they may draw there from strength and refreshment and whatever grace they have need of in the hardships of life, and especially at the hour of death.” (1209)



How to Pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy

The Chaplet is prayed on ordinary Rosary beads as follows:

1. Begin with the Sign of the Cross, Our Father, Hail Mary, and the Apostles' Creed.

2. On the Our Father beads, pray the following:

Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

3. On the ten Hail Mary beads, pray the following:

For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

4. Repeat steps two and three for all five decades.

5. Conclude by reciting three times:

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

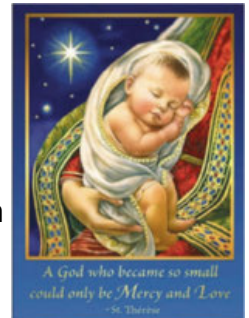
We meet Sundays from 10 -11, between the 9 AM and the 11 AM Masses, in the St Vincent Ferrer Rectory conference room.
