

# Reflection on Sunday's Readings 12th Sunday in Ordinary Jime

June 22<sup>nd</sup> was the Feast Day of Saints Thomas More and John Fisher. It was also the kickoff for Religious Freedom Week. You may not be aware of any of these events, but you should be.

homas More was born to an affluent business and professional English family in 1478. He was brilliant, was admitted to study at Oxford and went on to become a lawyer, writer and statesman. He served England in many ways and for these contributions he was knighted by King Henry VIII, who also made More his most trusted consultant. All this made More a very wealthy and influential man. He was friends with very powerful people throughout Europe including Pope Paul III.

But More was much more interested in the wellbeing of the Church in England, and of his country- which to him meant the people of England. One of his primary goals was to positively influence the King to help prevent Henry VIII from breaking with the Catholic Church. This caused More to become increasingly alienated from Henry and in increasingly greater danger. In a fictional work written while he was still held in good standing by the King and his court, More compares a courtier who enjoys a prince's favor to someone playing with tamed lions and notes, "suddenly the fun becomes fatal".

Henry demanded that More sign an oath in which he claimed to be the supreme head of the Church. You may recall that all this occurred when a sizable number of people quit Catholicism and formed what we now call Protestantism. The turbulent social atmosphere was international. Nevertheless, More continued defending Catholic orthodoxy with steadfast intent, and devotion to the One True King. John Cardinal Fisher was a consummate shepherd whose service to his small diocese was especially marked by his humility and dedication to his local church. Not inclined to

seek greater influence or power, he was an unassuming servant- but with the heart of a true lion. He also refused the demand of King Henry to be accepted as the supreme head of the Church in England, and rebuked Henry's claim to sovereign power over English Christians. They were convicted of treason, jailed and eventually beheaded. They are both now saints of the Church.

When faced with difficulty, the Prophet Jeremiah said, "... the LORD is with me, like a mighty champion- my persecutors will stumble, they will not triumph." In tough times, the Psalmist declared, "For your sake I bear insult, and shame covers my face. I have become an outcast to my brothers, a stranger to my mother's children. Because zeal for your house consumes me, and the insults of those who blaspheme you fall upon me." Jesus said, "Fear no one. Nothing is concealed that will not be revealed, nor secret that will not be known. So do not be afraid; you are worth more than many sparrows. Everyone who acknowledges me before others I will acknowledge before my heavenly Father." Saint Paul reminds us of, "how much more did the grace of God and the gracious gift of the one man Jesus Christ overflow for the many." God is good. You belong to Him. He is with you. That is all we need.



#### Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles

Soon after Christ began his public ministry, He called his twelve Apostles. In his Gospel, Saint Luke names the twelve: "Simon, whom he named Peter, and his brother Andrew, James, John, Philip, Bartholomew, Matthew, Thomas, James the son of Alphaeus, Simon who was called a Zealot, and Judas the son of James, and Judas Iscariot, who became a traitor." (Luke 6:14-16) Later, in Acts of the Apostles 1:26, St. Luke reports that Matthias was called to replace Judas Iscariot. Why, then, is this Thursday's feast called "Peter and Paul, Apostles?"

There is, of course, no question that Peter was an Apostle. The Gospels all agree that he was the first called by Christ. The primacy of Peter was well-established even in the early Church. In Matthew 16:18, Christ names Peter as the rock upon which the Church was to be built, and charges him with pastoring the flock of Christ. Peter was to take the leading role in the initial church as described in the Acts of the Apostles. Among scholars, Peter is recognized as the most prominent and influential member of the Apostles both during Jesus' ministry and in the early years of the Church.

Paul, not one of the twelve, is nevertheless counted as an Apostle. We can trace the earliest references to Paul being called Apostle to Paul himself, who, in Galatians 1:1 writes, "Paul, an apostle not from human beings nor through a human being but through Jesus Christ and God the Father who raised him from the dead...." Similar statements are made by Paul in Romans 1:1, 1 Corinthians 1:1, and 1 Corinthians 9:1-2.

We celebrate the Conversion of St. Paul in January. The conversion of Saul, persecutor of the Church, to Paul, defender of the Church, has proven to be perhaps the most fruitful conversion of the early Church. Paul was converted not by the preaching of the other Apostles, but by a vision of Christ himself. At least seven of the fourteen letters in the New



Testament are attributed to Paul by most scholars. These seven (Galatians, First Thessalonians, First Corinthians, Second Corinthians, Romans, Philippians, and Philemon) are believed to have been written within the first thirty years after the Resurrection and not only show the growth of the Church, but also the development of theology in the first century of the Church.

If we imagine Peter as the bricks on which the Church was built, Paul's task would be as the mortar holding those bricks together. Separately, the bricks and mortar are unused building material. Together, they can create an edifice strong enough to withstand the greatest winds. As Christ said to Peter in Matthew 16:18, "the gates of the netherworld shall not prevail against [Christ's church.]"

## School of Christian Formation Returns to SVF!

SVF is happy to announce that the Diocesan School of Christian Formation is returning to our campus. This three year program consists of four courses per year, each with six sessions of two hours each. The first course, *Introduction to the Bible*, will begin on Tuesday, August 8 at 7:00 pm in Kellaghan Hall.

Courses are designed to be informative, informal and fun! The text books are reader friendly, and there are no papers to write or tests to take. The fee for each class is just \$10, and most textbooks cost \$15 or less.
