Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time - July 25, 2021



“There is a boy here who has five barley loaves and two fish; but what good are these for so many?” John 6:9

Have you ever noticed that sometimes when you bring your gifts to Jesus as this young boy did, nothing much seems to happen? They just seem to sit there, undeveloped and underappreciated. Did you ever think that perhaps, to use a business parallel, the blockage is on the distribution side?

Jesus didn't tell his disciples to just sit quietly while he multiplied the loaves. He told them to have the people recline - he told them to get the crowd ready for the miracle he was about to do. Similarly, Elisha didn't explain away his servant's objections, he simply repeated his instruction: “Give [the food] to the people to eat” (2 Kings 4:43). It wasn't time to sit by and wait for Jesus to do something; it was time to get to work! And so the disciples organized the people into groups sitting on the grass, and Elisha's servant started handing out the food. That's when the miracles happened.

So if you want to see your offerings to God multiplied, you have an essential role to play. You may not be working the miracle yourself, but you do need to get out there and do something! It's impossible to know what that “something” is in each situation. We all have different gifts, different life situations, different opportunities that will present themselves today. But one thing is sure: Each of us will have an opportunity to something important for the kingdom of God.

Starting today, try your best to be open to your Father's promptings when it comes to the people you meet, the situations you encounter, and the movements of your heart. And then take a step in whatever direction you think he is leading you. The result may surprise you!

*“Heavenly Father, I am not sure how to start.
But I will take a step in faith today.
Show me what you have for me to do,
and how my gifts can bear fruit for your kingdom.”*

You're Remembered Now & Forever



In June of 1984, I drove from Daytona Beach to Oradell, New Jersey for a business appointment. My meeting was scheduled for 11:00 am on the 19th. I tried to get into a positive frame of mind before the meeting. I knelt beside my bed and prayed. *'Oh God, if you know who I am and care about me at all, please let me know in some way.'* As I opened my eyes, the digital clock in the room showed 10:44, the month and year of my birth. Maybe that coincidence was an answer to my prayer. It was also the 19th of the month – a whole number 19 or a 10 and a 9. Either way it was the 1900's and I was born on the 9th day of the 10th month. More coincidence. What else? My room number was 130. I had no idea when I was born but would ask my mother when I returned to Daytona. I did and she answered *"1:30 in the morning."*

Psalm 112:6: *"The righteous shall be remembered forever"*. When you are remembered it is by your name. You have a one-on-one relationship with your Father and your Savior. Jesus mentions your name as he intercedes for you to the Father. John 10:3: *"He (Jesus the Shepherd) calls his own sheep by name and leads them out."* We are not lost in the crowd; we are singled out by name. He knows all about us.


When you read this prayer of King David, it becomes his prayer for you in that moment as it was for me: *"The LORD answer you in time of distress; the name of the God of Jacob defend you! CONSECRATION TO GOD THE FATHER



We are invited to celebrate the Feast Day of God the Father of All Mankind.

Over the years, our parishioners have come together to celebrate this feast day preceded by 8 days of prayers in preparation for the Consecration to the Father of All Mankind.

Consecration books, chaplets, and medals are available for purchase in the church gift shop. **God the Father desires all His children to return home to Him in repentance and love.**

Mother Eugenia, an incredibly gifted Italian nun and mystic, lived in the 1930s. She received the only private revelation made personally by God the Father and recognized as authentic by the Church. God The Father told her:

"Do not think of Me as that frightening old man whom men depict in their pictures and books. I am neither younger nor older than My Son and My Holy Spirit".....".I know your needs, your desires, and everything in your hearts. But how happy and grateful I would be if I saw you coming to Me and confiding in Me your needs, like a son who has total trust in his father"....."I wish to be the hope of humanity. Am I not already? Man would be lost if I were not his hope. But it is necessary for me to be recognized as such so that peace, confidence and love may enter men's hearts and put them in contact with their Father in heaven and on earth!"

Gospel Meditation

St. Oscar Romero said, "We cannot do everything, and there is a sense of liberation in realizing that. This enables us to do something and to do it very well. It may be incomplete, but it is the beginning, a step along the way, an opportunity for the Lord's grace to enter and do the rest."

There were a group of ladies many years ago who made quilts. They were beautiful creations reflecting inspirational designs artfully composed from the simple scraps of fabric each woman would bring to their individual pieces. There was no plan for the finished project as each finished work became the combined creation of what each woman contributed. They abounded in vibrant colors and dazzled the beholder with intricate patterns and their myriad textures. They were so beautiful that they became coveted family treasures passed from generation to generation. Those women never realized the power of their work. Countless babies rested in the comfort of those quilts warmly nestled in the legacy of tradition they were fortunate to inherit. They adorned countless homes with their beauty and brought joy and solace to many faces.

We cannot do everything. We are not meant to. Our work in life is to contribute our individual piece, a piece that reflects the unique thumbprint I claim as my own. We only have to do small things well. Then, as St. Oscar Romero reminds us, the Lord's grace will enter and do the rest. We have to trust that this is true just as those women trusted in the eventual beauty of their final work.

Eucharistic blessings are blessings that start small and multiply. We all come to life with only a few loaves of bread and a few fish. Not any single one of us has all that it takes to transform our world. Who knows what God will do with the little we have and how many will benefit from our kindness, compassion, wisdom, courage, conviction, love, warmth, zeal, faith, and hope? That young lad never dreamed that his few leftovers would do all that they did. God shows up in unexpected ways! Where would life's adventure and fun be if it were any other way? Being able to be part of bringing God's creative, transforming, healing to the world opens us up to wonder, awe, and excitement! We can all bring our little piece to the bigger work of God that can result in being a coveted jewel passed generation to generation. This is good news indeed!






Radio Maria


