

Fourth Sunday Of Lent March 27, 2022

"But now we must celebrate and rejoice, because your brother was dead and has come to life again; he was lost and has been found."

(Lk 15:32)

"This fellow welcomes sinners and eats with them." (Luke 15:2)

With what scorn the Pharisees uttered these words about Jesus! How contemptible he had become in their eyes - a man who defied their conventions and shared fellowship with the very "sinners" they condemned. Yet for all of us who have come to recognize ourselves in these wayward ones, what gratitude we feel that Jesus would indeed welcome us.

The story of the prodigal son is one of Scriptures most intimate pictures of the grace and mercy of God. It presents a father severely wronged by his child, yet never rejecting him. Instead of a heart set on vengeance, we see a heart filled with mercy and compassion, a heart that simply wants to be reunited with a loved one. Even before he was asked to forgive, this father embraced his child and clothed him in mercy.

Imagine how startled this young man must have been! Far from the anger or coldness he might have expected, he was showered with love, mercy, and acceptance. The experience must have been overwhelming. Imagine his mind echoing the psalmist's: "I sought the Lord, and he answered me, and delivered me from all my fears" (Psalm 34: 4-5).

As moving as this parable is, it is also capable of addressing all our lives. Each of us has sinned against our heavenly Father and needs to make the journey home in humility. When we do, we will find him rushing to embrace us.

In this experience of forgiveness and cleansing, we come to know the truth of Paul's words: "If anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has passed away, behold, the new has come" (2 Corinthians 5:17). The forgiveness available to us in Christ is so powerful that it goes far beyond pardon for our misdeeds. It involves a re-creation of our hearts and minds. Today, as you receive Jesus at Mass, ask the Father to take you one step closer to this new creation. Let him shower you with the grace that not only forgives but also makes you into a new person - the image of Christ on this earth.

"Heavenly Father, I thank you for your love. Let me never forget your mercy toward me or your power to make me a new creation. Jesus, I want to become like you."



Knights of ColumbusThe Extra Mile Christian



When the Roman army occupied Israel, its soldiers could compel Jews to carry a burden for one mile. Humiliating as it was (Romans were loathed) Jesus asks them to do this:

"Whoever will press you into service for one mile, go with him two." (Matthew 5:41).

It's against human nature but a higher purpose lay beneath it: winning over an enemy. If his instruction was followed, the occupying army might see Jews in a different and more favorable light, and so treat them more favorably. What was the power of his words to change circumstances? Will we improve our lives if we don't repudiate those we don't like?


Social anthropologists defined 'The Social Law of Reciprocity.' When someone does something nice for you, you will have a deep-rooted psychological urge to do something nice in return. As a matter of fact, you may even reciprocate with a gesture far more generous than their original good deed. Many animal species show this trait.

In Luke 6:38, Jesus predicts what happens if we first sacrifice something of ourselves for others' benefit: "Give and gifts will be given to you; a good measure, packed together, shaken down, and overflowing, will be poured into your lap. For the measure with which you measure will in return be measured out to you." Wow? Giving initiates the receiving process.

Reciprocity from soldiers could mean a safer life for the Jews. If we treat others badly because we don't like them, the reverse happens – negative reciprocity. Our psychology turns upside down. We forfeit a benefit we could accrue, to assure ourselves of something we don't want, like disgust, retribution. Wow! Giving initiates the receiving process.

Attitude to others is a choice - with consequences - one way or the other. Let's go the extra mile. Peace be with you.






